OPENING KICKOFF

- The Spartan football team plays its final non-conference game of the season at an old MEAC rival this week, traveling to Greensboro, North Carolina, to face North Carolina A&T.
- NSU dropped its second straight game, falling to 1-2 in the MEAC, after a 49-21 loss to Howard last Saturday at Dick Price Stadium.
- **Jordin Lennon** rushed for 114 yards and a touchdown, while **Otto Kuhns** both rushed for and threw for a touchdown for NSU. Howard gained 460 yards to NSU's 229.
- **Ademola Faleye** caught his first TD of the season, a 14-yard pass from Kuhns in the fourth quarter.
- Since starting the season 0-3, the Aggies won their fifth straight game last weekend, a 45-38 victory over Campbell, behind 256 rushing yards from FCS National Player of the Week **Bhayshul Tuten**.
- A&T trailed 28-10 after the first quarter, but outscored the Camels 35-10 in the second half to remain unbeaten in Big South play.
- The Aggies are in their second, and final, year in the Big South. NCA&T will compete in the CAA next season.

SERIES HISTORY

- North Carolina A&T leads the series with NSU, 32-9, with two Spartan wins vacated (2010, '11).
- The Aggies have won the last five meetings on the gridiron between the two teams.
- The teams last met in 2019 at Dick Price Stadium, a 58-19 Aggies' victory. It was the last meeting between the teams as MEAC members, as N.C. A&T is now a member of the Big South for football.

LENNON HITS THE CENTURY MARK

- True freshman **Jordin Lennon** not only started his first career game last week against Howard, but notched his first career 100-yard rushing game in the process.
- Lennon ran for 114 yards on just seven carries. That included a 67-yard TD run in the third quarter, his

team-leading third rushing score of the year.

- The 100-yard game was also NSU's first this season by a running back. **J.J. Davis** had 115 at Delaware State last November.
- Lennon now has a team-high 254 rushing yards this season.

BUTLER FINDS A HOME

- NSU redshirt sophomore **Chris Butler** has bounced back and forth between receiver and running back during his Spartan career, but seems to have found a home at wideout.
- The native of Glen Allen, Virginia, He hauled in six passes for 88 yards, both career highs, in the win at Morgan State.
- Two weeks ago, Butler had three catches for 71 yards and one TD, a 42-yard catch, against Delaware State. It was his first career touchdown.

OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS

- Injuries have paved the way for more players to get opportunities to prove themselves. One such player is sophomore defensive back **Pierre Royster**.
- Royster got the start at Morgan State and registered two tackles for loss, including a sack. Against Delaware State, the local product from Lake Taylor notched seven tackles, a new career high.
- Royster has started the last three games.

TYLER TALLIES TACKLES

- NSU junior **Tyler Long** has been racking up the tackles of late. More on the standout linebacker:
- Long ranks second in the MEAC and is 19th in all of the Division I FCS with 75 total tackles in eight games.
- He has reached double figures four times, with 11 at Marshall, a then career-high tying 12 against St. Francis and a career-high 13 at Sacred Heart. He also had 10 against Howard.
- Long also leads NSU and is eighth in the MEAC with 3.0 sacks on the year.

YOUTH IS SERVED

After losing more than 30 letterwinners from last year's team, the Spartans have welcomed in more than 40 newcomers this season. That has led to a youth movement of sorts for the Spartans.

• To date, 15 true freshmen and 13 redshirt freshmen have played in at least one game for NSU.

• Four true freshmen have started so far in **OL Vincent Byrd Jr.** and **Lamar Robinson**, **RB Jordin Lennon** and **CB Emile Sancho**.

• Redshirt freshmen to start so far include **TE Ikeem Wright**, **OL Baron Franks**, **DL Levontae Jacobs** and **DE T.J. Stevenson**.

• True freshmen have led NSU in rushing in three games. **Jason Wonodi** led the way with 81 yards against St. Francis, all on a third-quarter TD run. **Kevon King** ran four times for 36 yards and a TD at Morgan State and Lennon ran for 114 yards vs. Howard.

BY LAND AND BY AIR

NSU has shown the ability to move the ball in different ways the last few weeks. The Spartans ran for more than 200 yards in back-to-back games against St. Francis and Sacred Heart, including a season-high 254 against St. Francis. Against Sacred Heart, six different players logged carries, with four rushing for at least 38 yards.

Against Morgan State, the Spartans passed for a season-high 291 yards, including a career-best 88 by **Otto Kuhns**. **Da'Quan Felton** (eight) and **Chris Butler** (six) had career highs in receptions. Kuhns then passed for 258 yards in the loss to DSU.

SPARTANS IN WEEKLY MEAC AWARDS

Here is a look at the Spartans who have earned weekly MEAC honors this year:

• **Sept. 26: RB Jordin Lennon** (Rookie of the Week)

• **Oct. 10: WR Da'Quan Felton** (Co-Offensive Player of the Week), **DB Stuart Anderson Jr.** (Defensive Player of the Week), **RB Kevon King** (Rookie of the Week).

BOMB FOR THE BOOKS

NSU's first touchdown of the 2022 season was an eye-opener. **Otto Kuhns** connected with **Da'Quan Felton** on a 90-yard scoring strike on the first play of the third quarter at JMU.

Based on available records, the play is the third-longest pass in school history, and longest in 11 years. **Chris Walley** threw a school-record 98-yard TD pass to **Derrick Demps** in the 2011 FCS playoff game at Old Dominion. In 2003, **Dontrell Leonard** connected on a 97-yard pass play with **Howard Gilmore** at Morgan State.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

• NSU was voted to finish third in the MEAC this season in the preseason poll of league head coaches and sports information directors.

• NSU had seven All-MEAC preseason picks. **RB J.J. Davis**, **C Colby Byrd**, **DB Brandon Savage** and **LB Marquis Hall** were first-team selections. **WR Da'Quan Felton**, **LB Tyler Long** and **DB Justin Toler** were second-team choices.

• Davis, the MEAC's leading rusher as a freshman in 2021, was voted the preseason MEAC Offensive Player of the Year.

• Davis, Byrd and Savage were first-team All-MEAC picks last year, while Hall and Long were second-team selections.

MORE PRESEASON HONORS

• In addition to his preseason MEAC honor, **J.J. Davis** was also named a preseason HBCU All-American by BOXTOROW and was selected to the preseason watch list for the Black College Football Player of the Year along with **LB Marquis Hall**.

SPARTANS IN THE PROS

Norfolk State is represented in the NFL by a pair of undrafted players who were All-MEAC performers at NSU: defensive back **Bobby Price** of the Detroit Lions and end/outside linebacker **De'Shaan Dixon** of the Jacksonville Jaguars.

• Price was a two-time All-MEAC safety for NSU who started 37 games between 2016 and 2019. Price spent much of the 2020 NFL season on the Lions practice squad. He made 18 tackles and broke up three passes in 15 games in 2021 while starting twice. He intercepted a two-point conversion pass in a win over Washington last month.

• Dixon (2017-21) has had a strong preseason and training camp in his first year with the Jaguars, who signed Dixon following the 2022 draft. Dixon led the MEAC in sacks and was first-team All-MEAC in 2021.

SPARTANS ON THE WORLDWIDE LEADER

• Ten of NSU's 11 games this year will be broadcast on one of the ESPN family of networks. The games at Marshall and JMU both aired live on ESPN3.

• NSU's non-conference games with Hampton, St. Francis and N.C. A&T plus all five MEAC games will be on ESPN+ at minimum.

• Games with N.C. Central and S.C. State fall on two of the MEAC's wildcard weekends, meaning if the games hold significance in the standings, they could be selected to air live on ESPN3 and tape-delayed on ESPN+. If not, they will still air on ESPN+.

ALL GAMES ON HOT 91.1 FM, SATELLITE RADIO

Campus radio station WNSB Hot 91.1 FM will serve as the carrier of all 11 Spartan football games this fall, plus any potential postseason games, for the second year in a row. Fans can also listen to the games online at www.tunein.com, or through the TuneIn Radio app by searching for WNSB 91.1 FM.

NSU's football broadcasts will also be available on SiriusXM. This weekend's game will air on channel 158/207 on Sirius XM and channel 983 on the SXM App. The SXM App is free for most subscribers, and anyone who is not yet a subscriber can download the SXM App and get a free, limited-time preview.

Additionally, select NSU men's and women's basketball games will also air on SiriusXM later this year.

DAWSON ODUMS // HEAD COACH



Dawson Odums, a championship coach with a track record of developing student-athletes both on and off the field during his collegiate coaching career, is in his second year as the head football coach at Norfolk State. He was named the 18th head coach in Spartan history on April 21, 2021.

Odums led NSU to a successful campaign in his first season in charge. The Spartans went 6-5 in 2021, which included a six-game winning streak that was the program's longest since 1984. Officially, the 2021 season marked NSU's first winning ledger since 2007.

A balanced, high-powered offense was NSU's calling card in 2021. NSU averaged 33.2 points per game, most in its Division I history and third-most in school annals, while averaging a MEAC-high 440.5 yards per game – another school D-I record. That included 212.2 rushing yards per game, second-best in program history and the most since 1984.

The Spartans had a school-record 18 players earn All-MEAC honors following the 2021 season. That included NSU capturing three of the MEAC's top awards – Offensive Player of the Year (Juwan Carter), Rookie of the Year (J.J. Davis) and Offensive Lineman of the Year (Justin Redd).

A native of Shelby, North Carolina, Odums has more than 20 years of collegiate coaching experience. Most recently, Odums enjoyed a stellar 10-year run in the Southwestern Athletic Conference at Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Odums directed Southern to a winning record in each of his eight full seasons at the helm of the program, including a 5-1 mark in the abbreviated 2021 spring season. In his last five seasons, the Jaguars posted a 29-6 SWAC record. His overall record with the Jaguars was 63-35.

After joining the Jaguars as defensive line coach in 2011, Odums was elevated to interim head coach two games into the 2012 season before earning the permanent head coach position following the year. On the field, Odums led Southern to a 53-17 SWAC mark over the last nine seasons. His ledger includes one SWAC championship (2013), one SWAC Coach of the Year honor (2013) and four SWAC West Division titles (2013, '14, '18, '19).

Odums' teams at Southern excelled in all three phases of the game. In the 2021 spring season, Southern ranked first nationally in blocked punts, second in third-down conversions, fifth in sacks and eighth in scoring offense. Southern finished the year ranked 20th in the FCS Top 25 Coaches Poll. Defensive end Jordan Lewis brought distinction to the Jaguars by winning the Buck Buchanan Award, given annually to the top defensive player in the Division I FCS. Lewis, who led the country in sacks and tackles for loss, also won SWAC Defensive Player of the Year honors.

Southern posted top-20 total offenses in 2015 and 2016 and a No. 13 mark in rushing offense en route to a SWAC West title in 2019. Odums' squads ranked in the top 10 in the FCS in punt return average four times, including leading the country in 2017, and also ranked top-10 in kickoff return average twice.

The 2013 season was a special one for Odums. His first full year as head coach at Southern culminated in a double-overtime SWAC championship game victory over Jackson State. The Jaguars went 9-4 that year, one of four seasons in which they won at least eight games on Odums' watch. They also won nine games and captured the divisional title the following year, 2014.

Seven players coached by Odums have signed with teams in the NFL or CFL. That list includes SWAC all-time leading rusher Lenard Tillery and Southern's all-time leader in receiving yards and return touchdowns, Willie Quinn. That list also includes two-time All-MEAC defensive end De'Shaan Dixon, who signed as an undrafted free agent with the NFL's Jacksonville Jaguars last year after finishing his career as a Spartan.

Odums' other coaching stints include a pair of stops in the MEAC. He spent three seasons at North Carolina A&T (2008-10), serving first as defensive line coach and special teams coordinator and then as defensive coordinator. Odums' first stint in the MEAC came as defensive line coach at Bethune-Cookman from 2005-07.

Prior to arriving at Bethune-Cookman, Odums spent three seasons at Division II Clark Atlanta. He served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator from 2002-03, then as interim head coach in 2004.

Odums' other stints at the Division I level include two years at Georgia Southern and one at Gardner-Webb.
