A&T's STARTING FIVE NOTES

The first of two meetings between the CAA's two historically black universities occurs tonight when the Aggies visit a familiar place in the Convocation Center on the campus of Hampton University. The Aggies are 2-1 on the road in the CAA. Tonight is significant for the league because its two HBCUs are meeting on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. It is a day that honors the heoric civil rights leader for his fight to champion equality, freedom and unity.

After tonight, the Aggies and the Pirates have played each other in three different conferences prior, including the CIAA, the MEAC and the Big South. The Aggies were 17-10 against HU in the CIAA, 11-26 against the Pirates in the MEAC and 1-1 against them in the Big South.

A&T has now trailed by double figures in eight straight games, dating back to the loss to UTEP on Dec. 21. The Aggies have surprisingly fought back in each of those games except UTEP and Charleston. They have even won three of those eight games.

After going scoreless against UNC Wilmington on Jan. 7, Aggies forward Marcus Watson has been on a mission in his last two games. He has scored a combined

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Kyle Duke only played two minutes against Stony Brook University (SBU) and has only played five minutes in his last two games, failing to score in both; SHOOTING: Duke went 0-for-1 from the floor, and he is 1-for-4 in his last three games; NOTES: Duke is a valuable player for the Aggies because he can play multiple positions, and he can guard multiple positions. He is one of A&T's better defenders. He can also drive the ball to the rim and finish.

1 F Jeremy Robinson (West Los Angeles College CC Transfer) 6-6 • 215 • Sr • Raleigh, N.C.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Robinson scored four points against the Seawolves on Saturday, but did not grab a rebound; SHOOTING: Robinson went 2-for-6 from the floor against SBU. He missed all three of his 3-point attempts in the process; NOTES: Robinson has started the past eight games for A&T after a high ankle sprain injury sidelined Austin Johnson on Dec. 18. He is averaging 6.4 points per game in those startas and shootng 45.5 percent. Robinson brings versatility to the Aggies offense because he can post and he can also step beyond the 3-point arc and knock down shots. Last season he led the Aggies in 3-point field goal percentage (.439).

2 G Love Bettis (Coffeyville CC Transfer)

6-0 • 170 • So • Pensacola, Fla.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Bettis played significant minutes late in the game against SBU. In his last three games, he is averaging 17.3 minutes after only playing a combined eight minutes in three games between Dec. 29-Jan. 4. He scored one point against SBU; SHOOTING: Bettis went 0-for-2 from the floor, including 0-for-1 from 3-point range, but did hit 1 of 2 free throws; NOTES: Bettis comes to North Carolina A&T as a winner. He won a NJCAA national championship two seasons ago by leading Coffeyville to a 27-3 record. He is an excellent 3-point shooter, shooting 38.9 percent (14-for-36) on the season.

3 G Kam Woods (Northwest Florida State CC Transfer) 6-2 • 185 • So • Bessemer, Ala.

LAST GAMES vs. Stony Brook: Woods is becoming one of the minutes played leaders in the conference. He has played more than 35 minutes in his last seven games. He played 39 minutes against SBU on Saturday, scoring 19 points and dishing out two assists; SHOOTING: Woods was 7-for-15 from the floor and 3-for-9 from 3-point range. He also went 2-for-3 from three throw line, including hitting some late crucial free thorws; NOTES: Woods comes to A&T with the reputation of being a big-time scorer. He has not disappointed thus far. He has started all 18 games he has played, but he did miss the Gardner-Webb game on Nov. 19.

4 G/F Marcus Watson (New Mexico State Transfer) PIS REB AST S FG% F1% 13.2 4.9 2.0 0.5 450 .705 6-6 • 235 • R-Jr. • Buford, Ga.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Watson only played nine minutes against UNCW, but has played a combined 70 minutes in the Aggies last two games. He had 18 points and seven rebounds against SBU on Saturday; SHOOTING: Watson hit a big 3-pointer against SBU on Saturday to get the Aggies to within one, 57-56, with three minutes to play. He was 8-for-18 from the field and 2-for-9 from three. He is 17-for-36 from the field in his last two games but just 3-for-16 from three.; NOTES: Watson is excellent at putting the ball on the floor and getting to the rim. He ended last season with a terrific Big South tournament showing, where he averaged 22.5 points, 10.5 rebounds. He had his eighth career 20-point-plus game game when he posted 20 against Elon on Jan. 11.

5 G Tyrese Elliott 6-2 • 190 • Fr. • Grayson, Ga.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Elliot did not play on Saturday. He marked his first DNP since Dec. 18 when he did not play against Norfolk State. It was his first DNP of conference play; SHOOTING: Elliott does have a buzzer-beater to his credit when he beat Hofstra on a game-winning tip-in on Dec. 31; NOTES: Elliott is another quick guard who can shoot the basketball. The freshman is off to slow start shooting the basketball, but should prove to be a valuable backup as a combo guard.

10 G Justin Brooks 1.000 2.0 6-1 • 185 • Jr. • Auburn, Ala. 1.0

LAST GAMES vs. Stony Brook: Brooks has not played since playing four minutes against Greensboro College on Nov. 26 SHOOTING: He has not made a field goal since going 1-for-1 against St. Andrews on Nov. 22. NOTES: Brooks is a walk-on guard who had an excellent high school career, but decided to just be a student when he first arrived at A&T. But later decided to walk-on and contribute to the Aggies program. He has played in three games this season and eight games in his career.

NOTES: Powell was the steal of the recruiting season for North Carolina A&T. Powell received offers from Elon, Mississippi State, Siena, Ole Miss, James Madison, Middle Tennessee State and Florida Gulf Coast before deciding to become an Aggie. 247Sports rated him as the nation's No. 41 shooting guard and he was the No. 16 prospect coming out of Georgia. He has played in three games this season.



13 F Austin Johnson (UC Irvine Transfer) 6-9 • 235 • Sr. • Austell, Ga.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Johnson has been excellent since his return from injury. He has provided the Aggies with the offensive and defensive post presence they lacked when he got injured. He had 10 points and six rebounds on Saturday, and has 19 points and 18 rebounds in his last two games; SHOOTING: Johnson went 3-for-9 from the floor but converted a key 3-point play that gave the Aggies 59-57 lead with two minutes remaining against SBU. The Aggies never lost the lead again; NOTES: Johnson spent three seasons at UC Irvine. Last season, he led the Big West n blocks per game (2.44) and ranked 23rd nationally. He leads the Aggies in blocks this season.

He played high school basketball at Hillside, where he led them to a 20-6 record and a third-round appearance in the Class 4A state playoffs.

NOTES: Hamilton followed in his brother's footsteps in deciding to play at A&T. Hamilton's older brother Amari played four seasons for the Aggies and played a key role as a shooter. Hamilton is also an excellent shooter. He has played in four games this season over a course of 16 minutes. As a senior at Southern Durham High School, he led the Spartans to a 22-6 record an Elite Eight appearance in the state playoffs.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Horton scored one point, but was magnificent on the boards against a good rebounding team in SBU. He had a career-high 11 boards, 10 on the defensive end; **SHOOTING**: Horton has struggled of late from the floor, going 8-for-27 in his last four games. He went 0-for-4 against SBU, but did go 3-for-3 against Elon on Jan. 11. He is 4-for-17 in his last four games from three; **NOTES**: Horton was ranked seventh nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (50.6) but has slumped lately.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Filmore has become a reserve over the past three games after starting the majority of the season. He had two points and one rebound. After only playing four minutes at Elon, he played 14 against SBU; SHOOTING: Filmore went made his only shot attempt on Saturday; NOTES: Filmore will be relied on to provide offense in the paint for the Aggies this season. He is also a big, strong body who should provide the Aggies with a strtong defensive presence. No Aggie on the current roster has played more games (103) than Filmore. He has averaged 2.9 points and 2.4 rebounds in his career.

LAST GAME vs. Stony Brook: Powell won back-to-back CAA rookie of the week honors early in the conference season. He had six points and six rebounds against SBU. He is averaging 13.3 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in CAA games only; SHOOTING: Powell went 2-for-5 from the field and 2-for-5 from the free throw line. He missed his only 3-point attempt. He is shooting 57.8 percent in CAA games only; NOTES: Powell came to Aggieland as one of the most highly-recruited individuals in program history. He sat out last season with an injury, leaving high expectations for him entering the 2022-23 season. Powell should proovide punch for the Aggies on the boards.

LAST GAME: No Games Played

NOTES: Felton was expected to be a major force in the paint for the Aggies both offensively and defensively. Felton was ranked a three-star recruit by Rivals and ESPN receiving numerous college offers from Appalachian State, High Point, UNC Wilmington, Mercer and Miami among others. He decided to attend Arizona State, where he did not see any action for the Wildcats.

4TH SEASON OVERALL, 1ST AS HEAD COACH ALMA MATER: U.S. SPORTS ACADEMY, '06



Phillip Shumpert was named the interim head coach for North Carolina A&T men's basketball on August 18, 2022 after serving as an assistant under Will Jones for nearly three years.

Shumpert joined the North Carolina A&T men's basketball coaching staff under Jay Joyner on November 4, 2019.

Shumpert will coach the Aggies wing players. He will also be responsible for scouting the Aggies upcoming opponents, assuring players are in the proper housing on campus, identifying and evaluating talent who want to sign with N.C. A&T and monitoring the academics of the student-athletes.

In addition, Shumpert will supervise the student managers and schedule and conduct community service appearances.

He comes to N.C. A&T after serving as the associate varsity boys coach at Starr's Mills High School in Fayetteville, Ga., for a season. He has also spent time as a basketball consultant for Georgia Hoop Circle for the past two years.



Shumpert got his start in coaching out of college at Columbia High School in Decatur, Ga., where he served as the assistant girls varsity basketball coach during the 2006-07 season.

From there, he began his first stint at Lawson Community College as the assistant men's basketball coach and recruiting coordinator. Shumpert left for a year to be the assistant coach/recruiting coordinator at West Alabama before returning to be the head men's basketball coach at Lawson from 2009-13. He also returned as head coach for one season in 2015-

In 2010, Shumpert had a historic year at Lawson. He led the team to a 25-6 record, a No. 21 ranking in the NJCAA polls and an Alabama Community College Conference (ACCC) North Division title with a 13-1 conference record. Shumpert won the Glen Clem Award for Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and Region 22 Coach of the Year for his efforts.

Shumpert coached and developed Lawson's first All-American in over three decades on top of four All-Region players in 2011. The following year, he led the team to a 24-8 record and brought in a 43rd-ranked class according to jucorecruiting.com. Shumpert also had three all-region and all-conference players and two NJCAA players of the week.

Shumpert prides himself on being a developer of talent. During his time as a JUCO coach, he has played an integral part in sending 45 players to the next level including 26 players who went on to Division I schools. He has facilitated and coached several AAU camps from 2004-15.

Prior to his successes as a coach and recruiter, Shumpert played college ball at Itawamba Community College, John C. Calhoun Community College and Albany State University. He graduated from The United States Sports Academv in 2006.

LAST TIME VS. HAMPTON

HAMPTON, Va. (Feb. 16, 2022) — The North Carolina A&T could not overcome hot shooting from the Hampton Pirates in a 93-82 loss inside the Hampton Convocation Center in Big South Conference men's basketball play on Wednesday night. Graduate forward Justin Whatley got the scoring going for the Aggies, grabbing his offensive rebound and immediately putting it back up for two. Trailing 4-3, Pirate guard Marquis Godwin scored on two 3-pointers to push Hampton's lead to 9-4.

Whatley had not hit more than two 3-pointers in a single game this season, but from the 15:34 mark to the 13:11 mark of the first half, the transfer knocked down four triples in a row to give A&T a 22-15 advantage. Whatley poured in a career-high 17 points and had five rebounds. The Aggies led 24-17 following a layup from graduate guard David Beatty, but the Pirates rifled off a 9-1 run over the next 3:27 to take a 26-25 lead. Freshman guard Kyle Duke checked into the game and contributed eight points down the stretch of the first half, but Hampton's accurate shooting proved too much as they took a 43-37 advantage into the locker room.

The Pirates shot 59.3 percent from the field in the first half and an unbelievable 66.7 percent beyond the 3-point arc. That trend continued in the second half. Godwin scored five of the Pirates first seven points coming out of the break to extend their lead to nine, 50-41. On the night, Godwin scored a career-high 27 on 10-of-14 shooting, including 7-of-10 from 3-point range.

LAST TIME OUT vs. STONY BROOK

SBU's free throw strategy nearly worked Saturday afternoon in men's basketball CAA play at North Carolina A&T's Corbett Sports Center. But after a couple of chances at tip-ins by the Seawolves, the A&T Aggies jumped up and down and celebrated on Cal Irvin-Don Corbett's court after a narrow 61-59 win.

- Marcus Watson's rebound and fastbreak 3-pointer from the top of the key pulled the Aggies to within one, 57-56, with 3:23 remaining in the game. The two teams went scoreless over the next 90 seconds until A&T senior forward Austin Johnson put back a Watson miss and drew a foul on the play from Frankie Policelli. Johnson completed the 3-point play to give the Aggies a 59-57 lead with 1:49 to play.
- A&T never trailed again, but that does not mean heartburn did occur down the stretch. With 21 seconds remaining, A&T sophomore guard Kam Woods made two free throws to put the Aggies ahead 61-57. Tyler Stephenson-Moore hit two free throws to make it a 61-59 game. Stephenson-Moore then fouled freshman Duncan Powell before the ball was put into play. Powell missed the front end of the one-and-one, giving the Seawolves a chance to tie or take the lead. Tanahj Pettway chose to tie the game as Bettis fouled him as he drove to the basket with 13 seconds remaining. However, Pettway missed the first free throw, leading to Stony Brook calling a timeout to set up the strategy of missing the second free throw on purpose in an attempt to get an offensive put back. It almost worked. Pettway missed the second free throw off the back rim, and Policelli had a point-blank look at the rim on the tip-in but missed it long. Stony Brook's Keenan Fitzmorris had a faint chance of putting back Policelli's miss, but he, too, missed, leading to an Aggie celebration.

ON THE MOVE AGAIN

The North Carolina A&T Aggies are on the move again. After spending 50 years as a member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, the Aggies will be playing in their third conference in three years when Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) play begins in 2023. A&T's 50 years in the MEAC resulted in 16 tournament championships, 12 regularseason championships, 10 NCAA appearances and two NIT appearances. A&T posted a 415-328 record in the MEAC before starting play in the Big South Conference for the 2021-22 season. During their first and only season in the Big South, the Aggies went 6-10. They finished fifth in the North Division to earn a first-round game and win over the Radford Highlanders before the eventual Big South champion Longwood Lancers ended the Aggies' time in the Big South with an overtime win in the quarterfinals. A&T accepted an invitation to the CAA in January 2022. Each sport, except for football and bowling, will compete in the CAA during the 2022-23 school year. Football finalized its final season in the Big South in 2022 to allow the conference to compete its automatic bid to the NCAA FCS playoffs.

The North Carolina A&T Aggies have had an unusually high number of coaches in the past 10 years. A&T has had five different men on the bench in that span. Despite the many changes, the Aggies have seen success with all five. Jerry Eaves left the Aggies in 2012 after going 12-20. Five-time MEAC tournament champion Cy Alexander replaced him. He won his sixth MEAC title in 2013 as he led the Aggies to the conference championship. He also led the Aggies to their first-ever NCAA tournament win, a 73-72 triumph over Liberty. Alexander retired during the 2015-16 season, and the Aggies replaced him with his assistant Jay Joyner. Joyner finished the season 5-5. Joyner went on to have two 20-win seasons before leaving during the 2019-20 season and was replaced by his assistant Will Jones. Jones finished the season 14-5, led the Aggies to the No. 2 seed in the MEAC tournament, and had a first-round win over Howard before COVID canceled the tournament. Jones led the Aggies to a MEAC Southern Division title the following year before leading the Aggies into the Big South Conference. Jones departed before the 2022-23 season and was replaced by his assistant Phillip Shumpert. Joyner, Jones and Shumpert all took over on an interim basis.

Phillp Shumpert's journey to becoming the North Carolina A&T men's basketball interim head coach took 15 years and many sacrifices. However, the path he took will have him walking into the 2022-23 A&T men's basketball season with 11 players who were on the roster last season, two Division I transfers, two junior college transfers and two true freshmen. Shumpert started as a high school boys basketball coach at Columbia High School in Decatur, Ga. He then moved on to Lawson Community College, where he served as an assistant men's basketball coach and resident assistant in 2007. The following year he became an assistant men's basketball coach at Division II West Alabama. After a year, he returned to Lawson State to serve as the head coach from 2009-2014. He then moved to Southern Poly Tech before the school shut down the men's basketball program in 2015. Shumpert's next opportunity came as an assistant coach at Jackson State before moving back to the high school ranks at Starr's Mills in Fayetteville, Ga. In 2019, he joined the men's basketball staff at A&T under former head coach Jay Joyner. After Joyner's departure, Will Jones became the head coach and kept Shumpert on the staff. Then, over a fateful weekend in mid-August (2022), Shumpert was told Jones would no longer be the head coach at A&T. He was also informed that he would be named the Aggies interim head coach.

A&T'S LETHAL WINGS

Any discussion about the Aggie wingmen starts with 6-foot-6 junior Marcus Watson (Buford, Ga.) and 6-5 Demetric Horton (Raleigh, N.C.). Watson and Horton were the Aggies top two leading scorers and rebounders last season, with Watson averaging 12.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. Meanwhile, Horton averaged 10.7 points and 4.9 rebounds. The two Division I transfers are the top two leading returning scorers and rebounders for the Aggies. Watson had a monster Big South tournament a year ago. He had 18 points and 11 rebounds on 7-for-11 shooting in a first-round overtime win over Radford before scoring 27 points and grabbing 12 rebounds on 10for-17 shooting in an overtime loss to eventual champion Longwood.

Horton had a hot start to the 2021-22 season, where he connected on 20 3-pointers in the Aggies first eight games. But teams began to focus on the Aggies sharpshooter, making it tougher for him to find open space to get off his shot. The Aggies added shooters during the offseason, something Shumpert hopes will give Horton more open looks. Horton also has good size for a guard, allowing him to muscle his way to the basket and draw fouls.

Watson signed with Oklahoma State out of high school but did not play for the Cowboys. He transferred to New Mexico State, where he scored in double-figures once before coming to A&T. Horton played two years of junior college before transferring Purdue Fort Wayne for one season. He has played in 34 games for the Aggies.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

The Aggies top two point guards bring with them a national championship background on the junior college level. Kam Woods and Love Bettis both won National Junior College Athletic Association natoinal champioships with Woods' coming last season and Bettis' coming the year before. Woods played at Northwest State, where JucoRecruiting.com ranked him as a top-100 JUCO player. He helped the Raiders to a 31-5 record and the NJCAA national championship. Before Northwest Florida, Woods played his freshman year at Troy and averaged 10 points per game.

Bettis helped Coffeyville JC to the national title in 2021. During his first year at Coffeyville, Bettis averaged 11.5 points and shot 45 percent from the floor, 40 percent from three and 93.7 from the line. In addition, he claimed honorable mention All-Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference (KJCCC) accolades en route to a 27-3 record. This past season, he secured firstteam All-KJCCC and second-team NJCAA All-American recognition after averaging 18.1 points while shooting 43 percent from the field, 40 percent from three and 86 percent from the line.

HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES (HBCUs) ARE ON THE RISE

The North Carolina A&T men's basketball team is one of four Historically Black Colleges and or Universities (HBCUs) slated to participate in the Boost Mobile HBCU Challenge, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced Tuesday. Twelve-time NBA All-Star and longtime HBCU advocate Chris Paul will host the event at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas, December 17-18. BIGGEST A&T LEAD LOST

A&T's national recognition as a premier HBCU continues after participating in the inaugural Invesco QQQ Legacy Classic, a four-team tournament that award- <code>BIGGEST A&T DEFICIT IN</code> winning actor and film producer Michael B. Jordan partnered with to promote HBCUs this past December. The Aggies have a rich, storied HBCU history, having spent 50 years in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), winning 16 conference tournament championships. Seven of those championships came between 1982-88, tying an NCAA record with Kentucky for consecutive tournament championships.

A&T has 116 all-time meetings between the other three participating HBCUs Hampton (66), Norfolk State (48) and Texas Southern (2). AggieLand is also home to Naismith Hall of Famers Al Attles and Hugh Evans. Attles became the first-ever player to have his jersey retired as his No. 22 jersey hangs inside the Corbett Sports Center. Evans served as an NBA official for 28 years (1973-2001). He was inducted in September 2022.

HORTON SELECTED FOR HBCU ALL-STAR GAME WATCH

North Carolina A&T senior Demetric Horton has been named to the watch list at shooting guard for the 2023 HBCU All-Star Game to be played Final Four weekend in Houston. Horton has contributed 11.6 points, 3.4 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.5 steals per game and has scored 11 or more points in six of eight FGPCT. contests this winter.

Horton leads the CAA in 3-point field goal percentage as he heads into the week having made 20 of his 40 attempts this season (.500). He is also third in the league in 3-pointers made per game (2.50). Hampton's Marquis Goodwin was also added to the watch list.

The 2023 HBCU All-Star Game will be hosted by Texas Southern on Sunday, April 2 at 4 PM on CBS and Paramount+. The 24 players – 12 per team – will be selected from members of the MEAC, SWAC, CIAA, and SIAC, along with Hampton, North Carolina A&T, and Tennessee State. Last season, Aggies legend Kam Langley participated in the game for A&T. He went in as one of the best helpers in NCAA history with 901 career assists to rank 14th all-time.

THE PORTAL

The Aggies dipped into the tranfer portal again this season for two Division I talents who are big men. Austin Johnson is a tranfer out of UC Irvine, and Will Felton spent one season at Arizona State.

Johnson averaged 5.8 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 80.6 percent from the free throw line at Cal-Irvine last season. He also blocked 2.4 shots per game, which ranked him 23rd nationally. Through his freshman and sophomore years, Johnson played 59 games and averaged 4.7 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. He led the team in field goal percentage as a sophomore at 52.4 percent. He shot 62.5 percent as a freshman.

Felton is the Power Five transfer this season after redshirting his freshman season with Arizona State. He spent his final high school season at Hargrave Military Academy in Chatham, Va. He led the team to a 31-2 record, scoring 15.6 points and grabbing 8.1 rebounds per game while shooting better than 74 percent from the field.

THEY'RE OUT

The Aggies are without two key big men this season. Will Felton, a 6-foot-9, 260-pound redshirt freshman out of Raleigh, NC, tore his ACL during an exhibition game in the preseason and will miss the entire 2022-23 season. Meanwhile, A&T veteran Harry Morrice is out with a signficant leg injury. Morris is a 6-foot-11 four-year senior out of Dundee, Scotland.

He has been an outstanding shot blocker for the Aggies. He can also step out and hit the three, gives the Aggies a big presence in the paint defensively and he can score in the paint. A&T will have to rely on Division I transfer Austin Johnson, fifth-year senior Webster Filmore and 6-foot-8 redshirt freshman Duncan Powell to provide some punch in the paint.

AGGIES GET A STEAL IN RECRUITING

The Aggies added two true freshman to their 2022 recruiting class over the summer. Point guard Tyrese Elliott and shooting guard Garrison Powell should help make the Aggies transition into the CAA an easier one. Elliott is a three-star recruit and the 11th-best player in Georgia. He averaged 16 points, shot 51 percent from the floor, 45 percent from 3-point range and 81 percent from the free throw line. He also hauled in four rebounds and dished out four assists per night. Elliott's performances translated into

a second-team All-State Class 7A selection and All-Gwinnett County and All-Region honors.

Garrison Powell is out of Atlanta and attended Holy Innocents Episcopal Sin Georgia. He was reported to be considering reclassifying down a year. Powell, who is rated as the nation's No. 41 shooting guard and the Georgia's No. 16 prospect by 247Sports, started to hear from more programs following his junior season. At the next level, Powell had collected offers from Mississippi State, Elon, Siena, Ole Miss, James Madison, Middle Tennessee State and Florida Gulf Coast among others. And he also had interest from Seton Hall and Missouri, Auburn, Maryland, Virginia Tech, Xavier and Stanford.

EVANS JOINS NAISMITH HALL

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame accepted another North Carolina A&T Aggie into its hallowed doors in Hugh Evans. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame recently inducted 13 honorees in the Class of 2022 in September 9-10 during enshrinement festivities in Springfield, Mass. Evans, a longtime NBA referee, entered the Hall along with two-time NBA All-Star and four-time NBA champion Manu Ginobili, five-time NBAAll-Star Tim Hardaway, two-time NCAA National Coach of the Year Bob Huggins, and the NBA's sixth-winningest coach of all-time George Karl.

On the women's side, the Hall welcomed five-time WNBAAll-Star, three-time WNBA Champion, and two-time Olympic Gold Medalist Lindsay Whalen, four-time WNBAAll-Star and two-time Olympic gold medalist Swin Cash and NCAA national champion and WNBA Coach of the Year Marianne Stanley.

Evans, a 2002 inductee into the North Carolina A&T Sports Hall of Fame, played men's basketball for the Aggies from 1959-63 under legendary head coach Cal Irvin. He scored 585 points in 72 games. The Aggies went 63-22 (.741) during Evans' time in AggieLand. After graduating from A&T, Evans served as an NBA Official for 28 consecutive years (1973-2001), tallying over 1,900 regular-season games, 170 playoff games, 35 NBA Finals games and four NBA All-Star Games.

Evans will join fellow Aggie Al Attles in the Naismith Hall. Attles played at A&T from 1956-60. Attles played with the Philadelphia/ Golden State Warriors (1960-71) before becoming one of the first African American coaches in NBA history. In 1975, he became the second African American coach in NBA history to win an NBA title.



WHAT'S LOVE GO TO DO WITH IT

You hear the word often, but you don't meet many people with it as their first name, like A&T guard Love Bettis. The 3-point shooting guard in his first year with the Aggies has an interesting story on how he became Love. Rhythm and blues artist Musiq Soulchild produced a hit back in 2000 that was a tribute to the beauty of love. He even came up with a catchy name for it, too. Love. Ross Bettis, Love's father, thought it was one swell song, so when his new son came along, the world met Love Justen Bettis.

Many people think Love is Bettis' nickname, but no, it is on his birth certificate. Love likes the name even though he admits that opposing crowds often have fun chanting and making fun of the name when he is at the free throw line. He likes the name so much; he hopes it becomes a family name passed down through generations. Bettis, who comes off the bench to average five points a game for North Carolina A&T, almost had two unusual names. His dad wanted him to be named Love Justice Bettis, but his mom thought it was too much, so they went with Justen.

In addition to liking the name, he likes the song too.

WEBSTER'S DICTIONARY

Webster Filmore has become an excellent story for the North Carolina A&T Aggies. He played in his 100th game as an Aggie on Jan. 4, 2023. He came to Aggieland as a walk-on in 2018 under then-head coach Jay Joyner. He only played six games, mostly in blowouts, during his freshman season. During the 2019-20 season, he played under Will Jones for a portion. He appeared in 27 games, averaging 7.1 minutes. He even made two starts during the season. When he was trying to find himself as a basketball player, his cousin Chanin Scott became a star on the women's basketball team, where she led the Aggies to the 2021 NCAA tournament.

By the 2020-21 season for Filmore, he had come into his own, starting 27 of 31 games played as the Aggies entered the Big South Conference for the first time.

He received an extra COVID season for 2022-23 and has used it to start all 15 of 16 games for the Aggies as he has gone from walk-on to reliable rebounder and defender.

POWELL CHANGES HIS APPROACH

North Carolina A&T interim head men's basketball coach Phillip Shumpert had some advice for his 6-foot-8, 225-pound power forward Duncan Powell. Take your skill set and strength and create offense in the post before taking the 3-point shot.

Powell took the advice, which proved beneficial enough to make A&T men's basketball history. The Colonial Athletic Association released its weekly honors on Jan. 2 and named Powell rookie of the week. Powell was also named rookie of the week on Jan. 9

The honor made Powell the first player in program history to earn a CAA weekly honor. Powell, one of the highest-ranked recruits coming out of high school in program history, showed why during the week of 2022. He combined to score 35 points, grab 19 rebounds, block two shots and record two steals as the Aggies went 1-1 in CAA action. Powell was also a combined 12-for-16 (.750) from the floor and 10-for-14 (.714) from the free throw line. In addition, Powell made the only 3-point shot he attempted during the week. Before winning rookie of the week, Powell was 2-for-19 from 3-point range. He opened the following week with yet another career high in scoring. He had 20 points and six rebounds against 23rd-ranked College of Charleston in a 92-79 loss at Corbett Sports Center on Jan. 4. Powell was 7-for-14 from the floor and 3-for-6 from 3-point range, earning career highs in field goals made, attempted and 3-pointers made and attempted.

On Jan. 7 against UNC Wilmington, he had five points, five rebounds, three steals and two assists in a 66-61 loss at Corbett. He averaged 12.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 2.0 steals for the week.

Powell's run started with Northeastern in the Aggies first-ever CAA contest. Powell scored a career-high 17 points and had seven rebounds, two steals and a block on 5-for-7 shooting from the field and 7-for-10 shooting from the free throw line in an 88-76 loss. Two days later, at Hofstra, Powell posted career highs in points (18) and rebounds (12) and secured his first career double-double. He shot 7-for-9 from the floor, 3-for-4 from the line, and made his only 3-point attempt in the Aggies 81-79 buzzer-beating win over the Pride. The win gave the Aggies their first-ever victory in the CAA.

Powell is averaging 13.3 points and 7.8 rebounds in six CAA games played this season.

THE THREE IS THE KEY

The Aggies are on pace to break the single-season program record for 3-pointers made in a season. They come into conference play having made 169 3-pointers, ranking them among the nation's best in 3-pointers. During the 2009-10 season, the Aggies connected on 265 3-pointers to set the program record.

That season, the Aggies had three players make 50 or 3-pointers, including Tavarus Alston (50), Nic Simpson (61) and Dwane Joshua (63). During the 2022-23 season, the Aggies could have the same scenario as Kam Woods (40) and Demetric Horton (40) have already surpassed 30 made threes. In addition, Marcus Watson has netted 20 threes already this season.
