TODAY'S MATCHUP

The Bryant University football team opens Big South play this evening against first-time opponent North Carolina A&T.

BRYANT VS. NC A&T

Bryant and NC A&T will be meeting for the first time in program history. The Bulldogs and Aggies have met in baseball, with the Black and Gold winning a pair of midweek games during the 2014 season.

WELCOME TO THE BIG SOUTH

Saturday night will be Bryant's first taste of Big South Football. The Bulldogs won five games as members of the Northeast Conference a season ago but will play just five Big South games this year, making each one that much more important.

WRAPPING UP LIU

Ethan Gettman's 37-yard field goal as time expired gave the Bulldogs their first win of the year, 31-29, last week at LIU. Bryant led 28-13 at one point but the Sharks scored 16-straight points to take a 29-28 lead with 55 seconds to go. Bryant responded with a game-winning drive that ended in Gettman's field goal. Ryan Clark rushed for three touchdowns, while Joe Andreessen had 13.0 tackles and recovered a fumble in the endzone for a touchdown.

BRYANT JOINS THE BIG SOUTH

The 2022 season will mark Bryant's first as a member of the Big South. Bryant played as members of the Northeast Conference since moving to the Division I level (2009-21). In April, Bryant joined the America East and the Black and Gold joined the Big South as an associate member in the sport of football.

FREDERICK TAKES HOME NATIONAL HONOR

Anthony Frederick was named the FedEx Ground FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week on Sept. 19 after posting 197 return yards and 232 all-purpose yards. He posted a 100-yard kick return touchdown to help set a new single-game program record for return yards. He averaged 39.4 yards per return, the second highest single game average in Big South history.

CLARK ACCOMPLISHES RARE FEAT

Ryan Clark accomplished a rare feat last Saturday, becoming the first Bryant player since Ricardo McCray in November of 2014 to rush for three touchdowns in a single game. Clark's three touchdowns runs came on gains of 4, 2 and 1 yards. He rushed for just 27 yards on nine carries.

GETTMAN HITS WALK OFF

Ethan Gettman joined Luke Samperi as the only Bulldogs to hit game-winning field goals at the buzzer in program history. Samperi accomplished the feat in 2018 at Fordham, while Gettman did so last week. The 37-yard field goal was a career long.

ANDREESSEN HAS ANOTHER BIG DAY

Joe Andreessen continued his torrid start to the year, posting 13.0 tackles and recovering a fumble for a touchdown at LIU. He now has 10+ tackles in each of the first four games, a first in DI program history.

ANDREESSEN, GETTMAN TAKE HOME WEEKLY HONORS

Andreessen and Gettman were both honored by the Big South on Monday, taking home Defensive Player of the Week and Co-Special Teams Player of the Week honors.

INTERVIEW POLICIES

Postgame Interviews: Bryant University locker rooms are closed to all media. A 10-minute cooling off period will be strictly enforced, after which the Bryant head coach and requested players will be made available to the media via zoom. Requests for visiting coaches and players should be made through the opponent's sports information contact.

Player/Coach Interview Policy: Interviews other than those immediately following a contest must be requested and arranged through a member of the Bryant University athletic communications staff. Interviews will be arranged by the athletic communication staff at a time that will not interfere with the student-athlete's academic schedule. Requests should be made at least one day in advance to allow proper notification to the player or coach. At no time will the home or cell phone number of a coach or player be released to the media. In the case of telephone interview requests, arrangements will be made for the student-athlete to contact the requesting media member.

MEDIA POLICIES

Working Press Credentials: Press and photographer media credentials will be issued to members of the working media only. Credentials for all Bryant home games can be obtained by contacting the Athletic Communications Office in writing or by telephone. Credentials will be left at will call. Press pass requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to a home contest to ensure space availability.

Press Box: Only credentialed members of the media, coaches, league officials and designated administrators will be allowed in the press box area. The Bryant Athletic Communications Office will provide a game program, current press release, pregame statistics and game notes prior to each contest. A full boxscore, play-by-play, drive chart and other applicable game material will be distributed at halftime and at the end of the game.

Media Work Room: Ample work space with power outlets, telephones and internet access will be available for media members who need to file postgame reports. For men's and women's basketball contests, the Bulldog Room, located on the second floor of the Chace Athletic Center, will serve as a media workroom and postgame interview location.

Radio: Radio stations planning to broadcast Bryant home contests must make arrangements with the Athletic Communications Office at least two weeks prior to the requested game. Telephone lines will be supplied by the university, provided the requested notice is given. All calls must be made either on a collect or calling card basis.

ECKHAUS FINISHES FOURTH IN JERRY RICE VOTING

Zevi Eckhaus finished fourth in Jerry Rice Award voting last fall, becoming the first Bulldog to achieve that feat. He threw for 2,392 yards, 21 touchdowns and just three interceptions in 10 starts. Eckhaus came in during the season opener at URI after an injury and went on to start the final 10 games, going 7-3 as a starter.

ECKHAUS NOT SKIPPING A BEAT

Eckhaus has not skipped a beat this year, ranking first in the Big South in passing yards per game (257.50), total offense per game (263.75) and passing touchdowns (7).

THE BASH BROTHERS

Joe Andreesen and Ryan Saddler formed one of the best linebacker duos in the country last season. They were both named First Team All-NEC after combining for 171 tackles and 14 TFLs. The duo has combined for 83.0 tackles and 11.5 TFLs this season.

FREDERICK HAS CAREER DAY

Anthony Frederick had a career day in week three at Brown, finishing with 232 all-purpose yards and two touchdowns. He posted a 100-yard kick return score and also caught a 24-yard touchdown pass. Frederick's 197 return yards set a single-game program record. He ranks first nationally in return average and fifth in AP yards per game.

DALY BACK FOR SENIOR YEAR

Jack Daly returns for his senior season after earning All-NEC First Team honors each of the last two years. Daly had 40 tackles and 7.5 TFLs last season for the Black and Gold. He has produced 81.0 tackles in 29 career games, setting career-highs in both tackles and TFLs last fall.

OFFENSE DIALS IT UP

Bryant had an offensive explosion the final two weeks of the 2021 season, putting up 110 points and 1,109 yards of total offense in wins over LIU and Merrimack. The 574 yards of offense vs LIU were the fourth-most in a game in program history, while the 58 points are the most by the Bulldogs in a game in DI program history. It was the first time in program history the Bulldogs had scored 50+ points in back-to-back games.

BRYANT BULLDOG ALUMS PLAYING PROFESSIONALLY

- Tom Kennedy, Tom Castigan, Daniel Adeboboye and Jean Constant are all playing football professionally.
- Kennedy made the Detroit Lions 53-man roster last year, throwing a touchdown pass on a reverse.
- Castigan is playing in the Canadian Football League with the Edmonton Elks.
- Castigan led the team with six sacks in 2021 and has three sacks this season.
- Adeboboye was drafted by Toronto in the CFL and has appeared in 10 games.
- Constant is playing for the Barcelona Dragons in the European Football League.

OFFENSIVE GAME NOTES

ZORRILLA HAS CAREER YEAR

- David Zorrilla shined last season, earning All-NEC honors. He had 47 catches for 623 yards.
- He made seven catches for 87 yards vs Brown before hauling in five passes for 115 yards at Duquesne.
- It marked his first-career 100-yard receiving game.
- Zorrilla had a career-high 11 catches for 98 yards vs Saint Francis U.
- Zorrilla posted six catches for 65 yards and a TD at Wagner.
- Zorrilla made nine catches for a career-high 147 yards in week 11 vs LIU.
- He has 10 catches for 111 yards this fall.

FREDERICK'S BIG 2019

- Anthony Frederick caught 45 passes, a Bryant freshman record, for 451 yards in 2019.
- Frederick posted at least one catch of 30+ yards in 5-of-11 games.
- He was the first true freshmen in DI program history to post a 100-yard game.

FREDERICK'S BIG 2021

- Frederick enjoyed a resurgence last year, posting 32 catches for 516 yards and eight scores. He averaged 16.1 yards per reception.

FREDERICK BREAKS OUT AT MARIST

- Frederick snagged 10 passes for 109 yards and two scores in week 4.
- He's just the 10th player in program history to catch 10+ passes.
- The 100-yard game is the first for a Bryant receiver since Sept. 21, 2019.

RAREFIED AIR FOR FREDERICK

- Frederick joined Jordan Harris and Jean Constant as the only Bryant WR to post 10+ catches, 100+ yards and 2+ TDs in a single game in program history.
- Harris did it three times, while Constant was the last Bulldog to do so (2018).

FREDERICK LEADS TEAM IN TDs

- Anthony Frederick caught a team-leading eight touchdowns last year.
- He posted three multi-TD games, the most since Jordan Harris in 2012.

FREDERICK FLIES AT BROWN

- Frederick posted 232 all-purpose yards and was named the national special teams player of the week on Sept. 19.
- His 197 return yards at Brown are the most in a single game in program history. His 38.7 yards per return is the second highest in Big South history.

FREDERICK AMONG BEST NATIONALLY

- Frederick now ranks fifth nationally in average yards per return and sixth nationally in all-purpose yards per game.

EDMOND BACK AS TOP TIGHT END

- Jihad Edmond is back for his fourth season in Smithfield and is the team's top tight end.
- Edmond finished second on the team with nine receptions in the spring of '21 and also helped the Black and Gold average over 170 yards on the ground.
- He finished with 27 catches for 213 yards and a touchdown last fall.
- Edmond has 49 catches for 441 yards and four touchdowns.
- Edmond posted a 40-yard TD reception at Brown and has a touchdown in three of Bryant's last five games.

COOPER REJOINS MERRITT IN SMITHFIELD

- Gary Cooper played high school football for head coach Chris Merritt and now he'll play college football for him.
- Cooper joined the Bulldogs as a transfer from the University of Indiana. He was one the nation's top hybrid tight ends coming out of high school.
- Cooper caught multiple passes in four of the six games he appeared in last year. He finished with 13 catches for 182 yards.
- He has two catches for 27 yards this season.

5 STRONG

- Bryant enjoyed a resurgence in its running game in the spring of '21, averaging 179.3 yards per game on the ground.
- That number was the highest rushing total since 2014 for the Black and Gold.
- Bryant churned out 255 rushing yards against Sacred Heart, the most in a game since the 2018 finale at Howard.
- Bryant averaged 151.5 rushing yards per game and had 22 rushing TDs.

RUGGIERI POSTS FIRST 100-YARD GAME

- London Ruggieri posted his first-career 100-yard receiving game at Brown, finishing with 119 yards.
- Ruggieri caught nine passes in the game and now has 16 catches for 208 yards on the year.

MUKENDI BECOMING HOUSEHOLD NAME

- Fabrice Mukendi averaged 59.3 yards per game on the ground.
- Mukendi posted nine rushing TDs and is averaged 5.9 yards per carry.
- Mukendi rushed for a touchdown in seven of the 11 games last year.
- He posted his first-career multi-TD game vs LIU in week 11 and added two more in week 12.
- Mukendi had a career day at Duquesne, rushing for 111 yards and a touchdown on 14 carries.

ECKHAUS HAS CAREER YEAR

- Eckhaus completed 82.8% of his passes (233-371) for 2,392 yards, 21 TDs and three INT in 11 games. He was 7-3 as a starter.
- Eckhaus completed 35 passes, the second-most in program history, vs Brown.
- Eckhaus threw multiple TDs in each of his last eight games of 2021.

A LOOK AT ECKHAUS' SEASON

- Eckhaus set freshman QB records in every passing category.
- He joined Price Wilson, Dalton Easton and Mike Westerhaus as the only QBs to throw for 2,000+ yards in a season.

ECKHAUS LEADING MAN IN BIG SOUTH

- Eckhaus enters the Big South opener as the league leader in passing yards, total offense and passing touchdowns.
- He's the only Big South QB with multiple games of multiple TD passes (2).

THE AC IS STILL ON

- AC White has scored a touchdown in two of the last three games.
- He posted a 25-yard TD in the first overtime against Brown in week 3.

BYARM BACK

- Ishad Byarm - formerly Finger - returned from injury to score a touchdown at Wagner. He was hurt in the first game of the spring season of 2021 at LIU.
- Byarm added seven carries for 29 yards and two TDs in the season finale at Merrimack.
- Byarm came to Bryant as a transfer from Charlotte.
- Byarm picked up where he left off, rushing for a pair of scores in week 1 at FIU.

BYARM NOTCHES FIRST 100-YARD GAME

- Ishad Byarm recorded his first-career 100-yard game at LIU in week four, rushing for 107 yards on 16 carries.
- Byarm averaged 6.7 yards per carry and had a long of 23.

POWELL HAS SOLID DEBUT

- Jalen Powell, a Utah Tech transfer, posted eight catches for 81 yards in the season opener at FIU.
- Powell caught 95 passes for 1,104 yards and six TDs in three seasons at Utah Tech (Dixie State).

PROCHASKA AND WHITE SNAG FIRST TDs

- Matthew Prochaska and AC White each scored their first career touchdowns in week two vs URI.
- White caught a second-quarter TD, while Prochaska scored in the fourth quarter.
- Both TDs came in the front corner of the endzone.

EUGENE IS AGELESS

- Derick Eugene is in his sixth year of college football, transferring to Bryant from LIU.
- He had 37 catches for 371 yards and five scores last fall for the Sharks.
- Eugene caught his first Bryant touchdown in week two vs URI.
- Eugene added four catches for 55 yards at Brown.

CLARK SHINING IN NEW ROLE

- Ryan Clark was Bryant's starting quarterback during the shortened spring 2021 season. Now, he's taking reps as Bryant's primary running back.
- He's posted 141 yards and four TDs on 29 carries.
- In week four at LIU, Clark became the first Bulldog since Ricardo McCray in 2014 to rush for three touchdowns in a single game.

DEFENSIVE GAME NOTES

ANDREESSEN BACK FOR MORE

- Joe Andreesen has earned All-NEC First Team honors each of the last two seasons.
- Last fall, he posted 80 tackles and led the NEC with three interceptions.
- Andreesen and Andre Brackett (2019) are the only players since 2010 with 3+ INTs in a season.
- Andreesen leads Bryant with 46.0 tackles through the first three games.
- He's the first player in DI program history with 10+ tackles in each of the first four games of the season.
- Andreesen also has 7.5 TFLs two interceptions and two blocked PATs.

ANDREESSEN NAMED BIG SOUTH DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK FOR SECOND STRAIGHT WEEK

- Andreesen's big Saturday at LIU earned him Big South honors for the second straight week.
- He posted 13.0 tackles, 1.5 TFLs and recovered a fumble for a touchdown.

ANDREESSEN IN THE BIG SOUTH

- Andreesen currently leads the Big South in tackles per game (11.5) and TFLs (7.5 total and 1.88/g).
- He ranks second nationally with 7.2 solo tackles per game and fourth nationally in total tackles.

SADDLE UP

- Ryan Saddler has been riddled with injuries during his career but he was on the field in the 2021 opener at URI.
- Saddler made a career-high 15 stops in Bryant's week 10 game at CCSU.
- Saddler made 11 stops in Bryant's game at Duquesne.
- Saddler posted 91.0 tackles, the seventh-most in a single season in program history.
- He was named All-NEC First Team and All-New England for his efforts.

SADDLER OFF TO STRONG START

- Saddler is off to another strong start this fall, posting 37.0 tackles through the first four games.
- He's added 3.0 TFLs and two pass breakups.

BASH BROS.

- Joe Andreesen and Ryan Saddler are forming quite the duo on defense. Due to injuries, the two haven't been able to play together much.
- They started each of Bryant's 11 games last year and combined for 171.0 tackles.
- They also accounted for 14.0 TFLs, 2 FF, 1FR and 3 INT.
- Saddler ranked No. 2 in the league in tackles and Andreesen was No. 3.
- The duo has combined for 83.0 tackles in the first four games of the year.

DALY SHINING UP FRONT

- Jack Daly earned All-NEC First Team honors each of the last two years.
- He posted 15.0 tackles, 3.5 TFLs and 2.5 sacks in four games during the spring '21 season.
- Last fall, Daly posted 40.0 tackles and has 7.5 TFLs.
- Daly is off to a strong start this year, posting 14.0 tackles, 1.0 sack and 4.0 TFLs.

DYSON JR LEADING BIG SOUTH IN SACKS

- Kenny Dyson Jr leads the Big South in sacks after posting 2.0 in a win over LIU in week four.

Chris Merritt was named the fourth head coach in Bryant Football history on Dec. 20, 2018.

The 2022 fall season will be Merritt's fourth as the head coach of the Black and Gold. In three seasons, Merritt has guided the Bulldogs to a 13-14 overall record, while producing 17 All-Northeast Conference selections, one NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year and one NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year. Bryant's defense has seen a resurgence in Merritt's three seasons, ranking first nationally in total defense, fourth nationally in scoring defense and second in passing defense in the spring of 2021, while finishing in the top 30 of scoring defense, rushing defense and total defense in the fall of 2021.

Bryant enjoyed one of its best seasons at the DI level in the fall of 2021, going 7-4 overall and 5-2 in the NEC. The seven wins marked the most since 2015, while the five NEC wins tied the most in program history. The 2021 season also saw the Black and Gold play its first-ever game against a member of the FBS, falling 35-14 at Akron. For his efforts, Merritt was named a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award, given annually to the top coach in the FCS.

Several Bulldogs shined in Merritt's system in 2021, with nine players earning All-NEC recognition. Freshman Zevi Eckhaus led the way, finishing fourth in the Jerry Rice Award voting and earning NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year honors after throwing for 2,392 yards and 21 touchdowns. Eckhaus was the straw that stirred the drink for one of the league's most potent offenses. The Bulldogs scored 30.0 ppg to lead the NEC. Fabrice Mukendi, another rookie, set Bryant freshman records for rushing yards (652) and touchdowns (nine). Defensively, Bryant placed three players on the All-NEC First Team; Jack Daly, Ryan Saddler and Joe Andreessen.

Merritt and his staff led the Bulldogs to a 2-2 record during a pandemic-shortened spring 2021 season. Bryant won two of its first three games to set up a showdown with Duquesne for a spot in the NEC Championship. Bryant finished the year ranked in the top 10 nationally in total defense, scoring defense, passing defense, third-down defense and first downs allowed. Chidi Nna was named the NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year and four others earned All-NEC honors.

The 2019 season was Merritt's first as the head coach of the Bulldogs. Merritt guided the Black and Gold to a second-half surge in his first year, winning four of his final seven games to finish the year at 4-8 overall. Bryant featured four All-NEC selections in his first season and produced some of the best defensive numbers in DI program history. Bryant allowed 23.4 points per game in NEC play, its lowest since 2015 and its third lowest in 11 years in the league. The Bulldogs also excelled in the redzone, finishing first in the NEC at 87 percent (20-for-23).

Merritt comes to Smithfield after spending 18 years as the head coach at Christopher Columbus High School in Miami, Florida. He posted an overall record 172-45 (.792), leading the Explorers to two state finals appearances (2014, 2018), five Regional Championships, 14 District Championships and an 80-4 record in district competition in the largest high school classification in the state of Florida. In addition, Merritt's program has produced over 100 collegiate football players in 18 seasons, including current Bryant offensive linemen Kyle Mann and Robert Perez and 2016 alum Brandon Dagnesses.

"We are very excited to welcome Chris Merritt to Bryant as our next head football coach," Smith said. "Chris is a proven winner that has developed Christopher Columbus into one of the top football programs in the state of Florida. He has won 14 district championships in 18 years, while also developing over 100 student-athletes that have gone on to play college football. His intensity and commitment to student-athlete development are the perfect fit for our Bulldog program."

"As we celebrate our 20th season of Bryant football, we are thrilled to have such a successful coach start the next phase of our football program," Machtley said. "Chris has a vast track

record of ensuring that he recruits scholar-athletes who can both compete in the classroom and on the field at the highest level. His values and experience are a great fit to ensure that we maintain our momentum of a growing national reputation."

Throughout his career at Columbus, Merritt received several recognitions for his accomplishments on the field. He was inducted into the Columbus High School Hall of Fame in 2018, named the Nike Coach of the Year in 2005, the Miami Herald Coach of the Year in 2014 and the Warren Henry South Coach of the Year in 2017.

During his time at Columbus, Merritt also worked heavily with USA Football, serving as the head coach of the Junior National Team in 2010 and as the defensive and offensive coordinator in 2011 and 2012, respectively. He also served as the defensive backs coach on the gold-medal winning U.S. U-19 National Team at the IFAF World Championships in 2009.

"First, I want to say how honored and humbled I am to be named the head football coach at Bryant University," Merritt said. "I want to say thank you to President Machtley and Athletic Director Bill Smith for the opportunity to lead the football program at a first-class academic and athletic institution. I'd also like to thank Columbus High School, specifically Br. Kevin Handibode and Dave Pugh for allowing me the opportunity to be a part of the Marist Columbus Community for the past 18 seasons.

"I'm extremely excited to hit the road recruiting and to begin work with these young men to develop a culture of success. It is my number one goal at Bryant University for every young man in our program to Expect to Win!"

Merritt also served as the head coach of the Hamburg Blue Devils in the German Football League. He guided the Blue Devils to a 48-9-1 record (.936), a pair of European Championships, a national championship and three-straight Charity Bowl Championships. Merritt is the franchises all-time leaders in wins and winning percentage.

Bryant will be Merritt's third collegiate coaching stop. He served as the special teams coordinator and defensive backs coach at Thiel College prior to his time at Columbus and spent two years as an assistant coach at Eastern Illinois University in 1993-94.

Merritt was a four-year letterwinner as a free safety and special teams captain at Indiana University from 1988-92. He began his career as a walk-on before earning a full scholarship and competing in three bowl games.

Merritt is married to Minnie and together they have five children, Megan Merritt, Ryan Merritt, Shannon Merritt, Allison Catala, and Robert Catala.
