GAME 16 CHARLESTON (14-1, 2-0) vs. NORTH CAROLINA A&T (6-9, 1-1)

STORYLINES

- After a 20-year absence, the College of Charleston men's basketball team is ranked in AP Top 25 men's college basketball poll coming in at No. 23. The Cougars received 116 votes after lurking the receiving votes column for most of the young season.
- Charleston's 14-1 start is the best since the institution joined in the NCAA in 1991. The Cougars have won 13 straight contests, good for the nation's third best winning percentage (93.3).
- Pat Kelsey's program currently sits at 52 in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball NET and 90 in the KenPom rankings. The Cougars lead the CAA in scoring offense (80.47 ppg), offensive rebounds per game (13.40 rpg) and 3-point field goals made (10.13 pg).
- The Cougars and Aggies will meet for the first time in program history during the Aggies first year as members of the CAA.
- Charleston is coming off a 76-74 overtime victory against preseason CAA favorite Towson on New Years Eve. Ante Brzovic had his second double-double of the season with a careerhigh 22 points and 12 rebounds. Ryan Larson went 4-for-7 from three with five assists while Reyne Smith grabbed a career-high four steals in addition to his clutch three to give the Cougars to lead in the final seconds of regualtions to help force overtime.
- Dalton Bolon leads the Cougars ten-man rotation averaging 12.3 ppg followed by Larson and Smith with 11.2. Jaylon Scott and Babacar Faye both average 3.4 rpg to pace Charleston on

KELSEY BIO

Pat Kelsey was named the 25th all-time head men's basketball coach at the College of Charleston on March 25, 2021.

The fifth all-time winningest coach in the history of the Big South Conference, he resurrected the proud basketball tradition at Winthrop University, averaging 20.7 wins per season over the last nine years in Rock Hill, S.C. No other Big South program can tout more wins overall or more conference wins in that time span.

Kelsey, 45, will lead yet another tradition-rich basketball program as College of Charleston ranks seventh all-time (.685) among the winningest programs in NCAA Division I history with the likes of Kentucky (.762), North Carolina (.735), Kansas (.727), Duke (.710), UCLA (.688) and UNLV (.687).

The 2021 Big South Conference Coach of the Year most recently guided the Eagles to a 23-2 campaign, a school-record 21-game win streak and Big South tournament title, earning the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid for a third time under his watch.

The brand of basketball that Kelsey instilled in the Eagle program was an exciting one as it gained national recognition receiving votes in both The Associated Press and Coaches Top 25 Polls. The Eagles also ranked as high as No. 2 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll and led the conference in scoring offense, averaging 78.9 points per game, which ranked No. 31 nationally.

A two-time finalist for the Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award and finalist for the 2021 Jim Phelan Coach of the Year Award, Kelsey compiled a 186-95 (.662) overall record and an impressive 110-46 (.705) mark in conference play. Winthrop also won the Big South regular-season title four times — in 2016, 2017, 2020 and 2021.

In all, 16 Winthrop players were selected all-conference, while three were tabbed Big South Player of the Year, one Big South Freshman of the Year and two Big South Tournament Most Valuable Player.

His previous coaching stops include his alma mater Xavier (2009-12), where he served as Associate Head Coach under Chris Mack as well as Wake Forest, where he served as Assistant Coach (2004-09) and Director of Basketball Operations (2001-04) under Dino Gaudio and the late Skip Prosser.

Kelsey graduated cum laude in 1998 from Xavier University with a bachelor's degree in business administration and marketing. He began his collegiate playing career at the University of Wyoming, before transferring and playing three seasons at point guard for the Musketeers from 1995 to 1998.

Originally from Cincinnati, Ohio, Kelsey and his wife, Lisa, have three children: Ruthie, Caroline and Johnny.



BATTLE TESTED

- Charleston opened the season playing six straight programs that participated in 2022 March Madness (Chattanooga, #1 North Carolina, Richmond, Davidson, Colorado State, Virginia Tech)
- All seven of the opposing teams the Cougars opened the season with (Kent State) were rated higher than the Cougars in the KenPom ratings.
- The Cougars have risen in the KenPom ratings after every contest this season after the starting the year at 196.

RECEIVING RECOGNITION

- The No. 23 Cougars have been rewarded for their efforts earning the program's first AP Top 25 ranking since 2022 and are currently ranked #2 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll.
- Charleston is ranked 52 in the NET Rankings of the season with a Q1 win over Kent State and a Q2 win over Virginia Tech.

WE CALL THAT A STREAK

• Charleston is 14-1 with wins over five NCAA Tournament teams and three defending conference champions (ACC, A10, SoCon), a title in the Charleston Classic, and the lone setback at preseason No. 1 North Carolina followed by a current 11-game winning streak. Charleston is the third team in CAA history to open the year 12-1 or better, joining the 1985-86 Richmond squad (16-1) and the 1983-84 George Mason team (12-1) (courtesy of the CAA).

SIGNING DAY SUCCESS

- The Cougars are bringing in the 40th ranked 2023 class by 247sports.com with the signings of Isaiah Coleman, James Scott and Mayar Wol.
- 247sports.com has Coleman ranked 58th in the class with Wol at 163rd to make up the top mid-major recruiting class in the country.
- Kelsey on the 2023 class "Our vision of building an elite program starts with elite talent. The talented core group of players we have here now combined with this class puts us in a position to grow. We say OUR CITY because we want to do something great TOGETHER as a city and as a basketball program. Charleston took a big step with this class."

STARS ALL AROUND

- •The Cougars have played a solidified ten-man rotation with nine Cougars averaging 15.0 minutes or more per contest.
- In the opening eight games of the season, six different Cougars led the team in scoring (Reyne Smith, Dalton Bolon, Jaylon Scott, Ante Brzvoic, Ryan Larson, Raekwon Horton), while nine have contributed double-digit points during at least one contest.
- CofC currently ranks seventh in the nation in bench points (33.85), 22nd in offensive rebounds/game (13.31), fourth in 3-pointers attempted/game (30.4) and fourth in winning percentage (92.3)
- UConn (13) is the only team in the country with more wins than Charleston. New Mexico, Purdue, Arizona, Fordam, Houston, Miami, UMass Lowell and Santa Clara join the Cougars with 12 wins.

WEST LIBERTY CONNECTION

- Dalton Bolon and Pat Robinson III reunite in Charleston after playing two seasons together at Division II West Liberty, a member of the Mountain East Conference in West Virginia.
- The backcourt combo played in 54 total contests for the Hilltoppers with 37 shared starts.
- During the 2020-21 season, the two had identical made field goal numbers on the season (171) as Bolon averaged 21.3 ppg with Robinson III posting 20.4 ppg. One of the two was the leading scorer during all but two contests that season, including a matching 20 points each on 1-7-21 in a 98-77 victory vs. Notre Dame College.

POWER FROM THE PORTAL

- The coaching staff added impact experience during the off-season with the addition of three graduate transfers in Ryan Larson, Jaylon Scott and Robinson III in addition to returning grad transfer Dalton Bolon from the 2021-22 season.
- Larson, the only Division I transfer, played 120 games during a four-year career at Wofford. Kelsey on Larson- "Ryan will bring a savvy veteran presence to Our City. He's a proven winner and brings it every night on both ends with a team-first mentality and leaves it all on the floor. Ryan personifies our culture in everything he does on and off the court and will be a special part of the program."
- •Last season's NAIA National Player of the Year Runner-Up Scott brings a physical presence at the guard position. Kelsey on the two-time All-American "He can pass and score like a guard, but his size, physicality and rebounding is that of a forward. 'Versatile' describes him best for sure. Jaylon can guard multiple positions as well which is an extremely valuable skill."
- Robinson III comes from the Division II ranks. The combo guard was a two-time All-Mountain East Conference First-Team selection, a 2022 All-Atlantic Region honoree, a two-time NABC All-District selection and the 2022 MEC Tournament MVP. Kelsey on Robinson III- "He's proven he can score at an elite level and competes with toughness and tenacity every possession. He fits our culture like a glove and his leadership will impact us on the court, but more importantly in the locker room and in our community."
- Ante Brzovic is the only transfer not associated with the word grad. The 6-10 Croatian comes from Division II Southeastern Oklahoma State and brings dimension that will be a separator in the Cougars lineup. Kelsey on Brzovic- "His combination of size, skill and basketball IQ make him a very dangerous player but to me, his ability to rebound at an elite level is his separator. He presents a tough matchup for opponents with his skill set and we're looking forward to him joining this movement happening in Our City."
