# **QUICKIE NOTES**

- The Aggies 13 conference wins in 2019 are the most wins they had in MEAC play since they went 16-0 during the 1987-88 season.
- The Aggies also had double-digit wins in the MEAC in 2017-18 marking the first time since the 1993-94, 1994-95 seasons that the Aggies put together back-toback double-figure wins in the MEAC. The last time they did it three years in a row was from 1985-88.
- For the third straight season, the Aggies will bring in a number of newcomers. The Aggies have had at least eight newcomers over the past four seasons including nine this season.
- Kameron Langley broke the school's single-season school record with 208 assist. He broke Glenn Taggert's 30-year old record as he set the record during the semifinals of the MEAC tournament.
- The Aggies will be playing the Demon Deacons for the sixth time and for the second straight season. One of those losses to Wake came in the 1995 NCAA tournament. The Aggies have never defeated an ACC school. They are 0-42 lifetime vs. the ACC.

- The ACC teams the Aggies have had the most trouble against is N.C. State and Duke. They have lost to the two North Carolina schools seven times apiece.
- In the three Aggie wins this season, the Aggies defense is only surrendering 48.0 points. Guard Tyler Maye is averaing 18.5 points in the Aggies three wins.
- In the Aggies nine losses, their opponents are averaging 77.0 ppg.
- Kam Langley has had five or more assists 46 times in his career and 10 or more assists eight times in his career. He had a career-high 12 asssists against Coppin State in MEAC tournament guarterfinal last season. He has led the Aggies in assists 63 times in his career.
- Langley has led the league in assistto-turnover ratio the previous two seasons.
- Jay Joyner has posted 39 wins over the past two seasons. That is more wins than any other coach in the MEAC over that same span.
- The Aggies are just 3-9 this season but all three wins have come against Division I opponents. Only Bethune-Cookman and Coppin State of the MEAC has as many DI wins heading into conference play.

## **ONE YEAR WONDERS**

- The Aggies have specialized in players staying for one year and making an immediate impact.
- The one-year talent started during the 2015-16 season when the Aggies brought in Ede Egharevba out of Albany Unviversity.
- Egharevba averaged 7.1 points and helped then interim coach Jay Joyner finish the regular season 5-4 before Joyner took over on a full-time basis.
- ▶ In Joyner's second full season, he brought in Oakland transfer Femi Olujobi. Olujobi led the nation in scoring over the first few weeks of the season and eventually helped the Aggies win 20 games and earn a postseason bid to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.
- Olujobi led the Aggies in scoring at 16.3 points per game.
- Last season, the Aggies had several one-year players come in and make an impact as the Aggies went 19-13 overall and 13-3 in the MEAC.
- Guard Qua Copeland led the Aggies in scoring while making 41 3-pointers after transferring out of Middle Tennessee.
- Forward Terry Harris led the Aggies in 3-pointers made with 60 and was one of the nation's best 3-point shooters. He transferred to N.C. A&T out of Eastern Michigan.
- ▶ Ibrahim Sylla transferred out of Colorado State and stayed one season to lead the Aggies in rebounding at 5.3 per game. He also led the Aggies in field goal percentage (.599).
- This season, the Aggies will look to Devin Haygood to be their one-year wonder after he transferred out of Youngstown State. He had two points in his Aggies debut.

#### PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- The Aggies have been successful over the past two seasons despite not having a preseason or postseason first-team All-MEAC player.
- This season the Aggies did not have anyone placed on the MEAC's preseason first team as point guard Kameron Langley was second team.

# ► JOYNER CONSIDERED ONE OF THE BEST YOUNG COACHES

- N.C. A&T head coach Jay Joyner found himself in a difficult situation in 2015-16.
- ► He was asked to take over for his mentor Cy Alexander mid season after Alexander retired from coaching with only nine regular-season games remaining.
- ▶ Joyner, who had never been a head coach on the Division I level, took over a five-win team and led them to a 5-4 finish in the regular-season before losing in the MEAC tournament.
- ▶ Joyner was given the head coaching job permanently before the start of the 2016 MEAC tournamet. The Aggies then returned for the 2016-17 season and with a totally different team than the year before, the Aggies went just 3-29 on the season.
- ▶ Joyner lost even more players from that team but managed to reload with Division I and junior college transfers and won coach of the year in 2017-18. Joyner was also named District 15 coach of the year after the season.
- The following year the Aggies lost talented players such as Femi Olujobi, Denzel Keyes and Davaris McGowens but still managed to win 19 games the following year For his efforts last season, Joyner was named a Skip Presser Foundation finalists for coach of the year after the Aggies went 19-13 overall and 13-3 in the MEAC. The Aggies are 24-8 in the MEAC over the past two seasons and have not loss to a MEAC school at home in two years.

## THE LANGLEY BROTHERS

- ► Kameron Langley is one of the best point guards in the MEAC. Langley led the MEAC in assists last season was 13th in the nation at 6.7 per game. In two years, Langley has compiled 287 assists in his career.
- ▶ But Langley is not the only college basketball player in his family. Three other Langley brothers have or are currently occuping the court in college hoops in Greensboro. He has squared off against all his brothers at some point in his career.
- ► Last season, Langley played against his older brother Keyford Langley of Division III Greensboro College. Keyford, who is also a point guard, finished with 14 points, five rebounds and eight assists with only one turnover in the Aggies 92-67 win.
- ► For his part, Kameron, had eight points, seven assists and two steals.
- ► Two other Langley brothers have come into the fold this season as twins Keyshaun and Kobe Langley suit up for the UNC Greensboro Spartans next season.
- ► The Aggies and the Spartans played at the Greensboro Coliseum on Nov. 5 where Kameron started for the Aggies and Keyshaun came off the bench. Kobe did not play.
- ► Kameron finished with seven points and two assists while Keyshaun finished with seven points and six assists.
- ► The two teams will play again next season at Corbett Sports Center. Kameron is 1-1 when playing against his brothers in an NCAA Division I college basketball game.
- ► There is no word on what their record is against each other when playing in the backyard in Greensboro.

# WHERE ARE THE FOUR-YEAR SENIORS?

- They are not on the North Carolina A&T menn's basketball roster.
- The Aggies do not have a four-year senior on the roster this season. It is not because they are a young team. In fact, the Aggies have three seniors on the team in Ronald Jackson, Andre Jackson and Devin Haygood.
- ► But the two Jacksons are junior college transfers and Haygood is a graduate transfer.
- The Aggies turnover the last three years has caused the Aggies not to have a four-year class.
- Last season, the Aggies only had one four-year senior in Amari Hamilton. In the future, however, the Aggies have plenty of potential to honor four-year seniors.
- Junior Kameron Langley has been at A&T since his freshman season. He will be the only four-year senior on the roster next season.
- Sophomores Tyrone Lyons and Webster Filmore have also been in the program since their freshman seasons.

## **NO FIRST-TEAM HONORS**

- ➤ The Aggies have not had a first-team All-MEAC performer since the 2010-11 season when center Thomas Coleman earned the honor.
- This is the longest streak the Aggies have gone without having a first-team performer.
- The Aggies have won a MEAC title since the 2010-11 season despite not having a first-team player.

**HEAD COACH JAY JOYNER** 

Jay Joyner was announced as the head men's basketball coach at North Carolina A&T hours before the Aggies faced Coppin State in a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Basketball Championship Tournament game on March 7, 2016. Joyner was named interim head coach weeks earlier on Jan. 29, 2016 after the resignation of Cy Alexander.

Under Joyner, the Aggies closed out the 2015-16 regular season with a 5-4 record overall and a 5-3 mark in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. After a tough season in his first full season as the Aggies head coach, Joyner first spearheaded one of the best turnarounds in Division I history before following up with a 19-win season that included a second-place finish in the MEAC during the 2018-19 season.

The Aggies 13-3 record in the MEAC in 2018-19 marked the first time the program has finished second since the 1992-93 season and it was the most conference wins the Aggies have accumulated since the 1987-88 season. Joyner also led the Aggies to 39 wins from 2017-2019. Those are the most wins over a two-year period since the Aggies won 50 games from 1986-88.

Joyner accomplished another feat that had not been achieved in a long time when he was named coach of the year in the MEAC following the 2017-18 season. He became the first N.C. A&T men's basketball coach to earn the award since Don Corbett received it after the 1987-88 season. He was also named the National Association Basketball Coaches District 15 coach of the year.

He was rewarded because the Aggies improved 17 games from the 2016-17 season to the 2017-18 season coming one game shy of tying UTEP's 18-game improvement in 2003-04. The Aggies finished 20-15 (.571) in 2017-18 marking the Aggies first 20-win season in five years and just the third in the past 30 years. The Aggies also put together their best winning percentage since the 1991-92 season. Their 18 regular-season wins were the most since '91-92.

Joyner led the Aggies to their first MEAC tournament win in five seasons when the Aggies won twice in the 2017-18 conference tournament. Their No. 4 seed in the tournament was the school's highest seeding since 2009. Joyner also led the Aggies to their first undefeated season at home

in 30 seasons as the Aggies went 12-0 at Corbett Sports Center. In fact, the Aggies have won 17 straight games at home against conference foes under Joyner's leadership.

The 2017-18 season saw the Aggies break the school single-season record for points (2,623). The following season, point guard Kameron Langley broke the school's single-season assists record (208).

Before becoming N.C. A&T's head coach, Joyner furthered his longtime relationship with Alexander as he served as the Aggies associate head coach (2012-16) under Alexander. Previously Joyner had played for Alexander as a student-athlete at S.C. State. He also worked with Alexander as an assistant prior to N.C. A&T. Alexander even served on Joyner's staff at Columbia State Community College.

As the Aggies associate head coach, Joyner took the lead in the Aggies recruiting efforts. In his first season with the Aggies program, the Aggies won the MEAC title, won its first-ever NCAA tournament game and won 20 games for the first time in 25 years. Before coming to Greensboro, Joyner spent three seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Columbia State Community College, a two-year school in Middle Tennessee. Joyner led the Chargers to a 61-23 record and two Tennessee Community College Athletic Association regular-season titles.

In 2012, the Charges made their first national tournament appearance in 34 years. The 2011-12 team went 23-8 and finished the season ranked sixth in the nation. Joyner earned the 2011-12 National Junior College Athletic Association District 7 Coach of the Year honor and was named the TCCAA Coach of the Year in 2010 and '12.

Joyner spent the 2008-2009 season as an assistant coach for the Cumberland University men's basketball program, a National Association Intercollegiate Athletics institution, in Lebanon, Tenn. He helped the Bulldogs to an NAIA National Championship Tournament appearance with a 26-6 record.

Prior to finding success in Tennessee, Joyner gained experience working in the Big East. Joyner served as the director of player development for Rutgers University (2006-08), and spent two seasons developing and managing the Scarlett Knights' mentoring program. He worked with each student-athlete to help enhance their athletic performance, handled NCAA compliance documentation for student-athletes, served as the campus liaison for recruits and assisted with scheduling.

His coaching career began in Tennessee, where he served as the assistant coach at Columbia State Community College for the 2005-06 season, helping guide the Chargers to the conference championship game under head coach Malcolm Montgomery.

Joyner got his professional start in athletics in 2003, where he served as the administrative assistant/assistant strength coach for the men's basketball program at Tennessee State under Alexander. Before making the jump to collegiate athletics, Joyner was an assistant boys basketball coach at Centennial High School in Franklin, Tenn., for the 2002-03 season.
