A&T's STARTING FIVE NOTES

1

The Aggies have not played a basketball game this month. Their last contest resulted in a 73-56 win over crosstown rival UNC Greensboro on Nov. 30 at Corbett Sports Center. It marked their first win over UNCG in five tries.

2

The Aggies thought they may have to face the No. 1 team in the nation, something that has not happened since 2013. But the Aggies will get a top-5 opponent in the Houston Cougars. The Aggies are 0-16 against the AP Top-25.

3

Phillip Shumpert leads A&T on an interim basis, taking over the program in August. Shumpert is the Aggies fifth head coach since 2012. Three of those coaches took over on an interim basis.

4

A&T comes into the game on a three-game winning streak, having won all three by double figures. The win over UNCG marked the Aggies first win over a Division I opponent this season.

5

After Houston, the A&T is headed to Las Vegas for Chris Paul's HBCU Challenge. The other HBCU's include Hampton, Texas Southern and Norfolk State. A&T is the largest historically black college in the nation with more than 13,000 students.

PHILLIP SHUMPERT

INTERIM HEAD COACH
4TH SEASON OVERALL, 1ST AS HEAD COACH

Phillip Shumpert was named the interim head coach for North Carolina A&T men's basketball on August 18, 2022 after serving as an assistant under Will Jones for nearly three years.

Shumpert joined the North Carolina A&T men's basketball coaching staff under Jay Joyner on November 4, 2019.

Shumpert will coach the Aggies wing players. He will also be responsible for scouting the Aggies upcoming opponents, assuring players are in the proper housing on campus, identifying and evaluating talent who want to sign with N.C. A&T and monitoring the academics of the student-athletes.

In addition, Shumpert will supervise the student managers and schedule and conduct community service appearances.

He comes to N.C. A&T after serving as the associate varsity boys coach at Starr's Mills High School in Fayetteville, Ga., for a season. He has also spent time as a basketball consultant for Georgia Hoop Circle for the past two years.



Shumpert got his start in coaching out of college at Columbia High School in Decatur, Ga., where he served as the assistant girls varsity basketball coach during the 2006-07 season.

From there, he began his first stint at Lawson Community College as the assistant men's basketball coach and recruiting coordinator. Shumpert left for a year to be the assistant coach/recruiting coordinator at West Alabama before returning to be the head men's basketball coach at Lawson from 2009-13. He also returned as head coach for one season in 2015-16.

In 2010, Shumpert had a historic year at Lawson. He led the team to a 25-6 record, a No. 21 ranking in the NJCAA polls and an Alabama Community College Conference (ACCC) North Division title with a 13-1 conference record. Shumpert won the Glen Clem Award for Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and Region 22 Coach of the Year for his efforts.

Shumpert coached and developed Lawson's first All-American in over three decades on top of four All-Region players in 2011. The following year, he led the team to a 24-8 record and brought in a 43rd-ranked class according to jucorecruiting.com. Shumpert also had three all-region and all-conference players and two NJCAA players of the week.

Shumpert prides himself on being a developer of talent. During his time as a JUCO coach, he has played an integral part in sending 45 players to the next level including 26 players who went on to Division I schools. He has facilitated and coached several AAU camps from 2004-15.

Prior to his successes as a coach and recruiter, Shumpert played college ball at Itawamba Community College, John C. Calhoun Community College and Albany State University. He graduated from The United States Sports Academy in 2006.

ON THE MOVE AGAIN

The North Carolina A&T Aggies are on the move again. After spending 50 years as a member of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, the Aggies will be playing in their third conference in three years when Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) play begins in 2023. A&T's 50 years in the MEAC resulted in 16 tournament championships, 12 regular-season championships, 10 NCAA appearances and two NIT appearances. A&T posted a 415-328 record in the MEAC before starting play in the Big South Conference for the 2021-22 season. During their first and only season in the Big South, the Aggies went 6-10. They finished fifth in the North Division to earn a first-round game and win over the Radford Highlanders before the eventual Big South champion Longwood Lancers ended the Aggies' time in the Big South with an overtime win in the quarterfinals. A&T accepted an invitation to the CAA in January 2022. Each sport, except for football and bowling, will compete in the CAA during the 2022-23 school year. Football finalized its final season in the Big South in 2022 to allow the conference to compete its automatic bid to the NCAA FCS playoffs.

MANY COACHES IN A SHORT TIME

The North Carolina A&T Aggies have had an unusually high number of coaches in the past 10 years. A&T has had five different men on the bench in that span. Despite the many changes, the Aggies have seen success with all five. Jerry Eaves left the Aggies in 2012 after going 12-20. Five-time MEAC tournament champion Cy Alexander replaced him. He won his sixth MEAC title in 2013 as he led the Aggies to the conference championship. He also led the Aggies to their first-ever NCAA tournament win, a 73-72 triumph over Liberty. Alexander retired during the 2015-16 season, and the Aggies replaced him with his assistant Jay Joyner. Joyner finished the season 5-5. Joyner went on to have two 20-win seasons before leaving during the 2019-20 season and was replaced by his assistant Will Jones. Jones finished the season 14-5, led the Aggies to the No. 2 seed in the MEAC tournament, and had a first-round win over Howard before COVID canceled the tournament. Jones led the Aggies to a MEAC Southern Division title the following year before leading the Aggies into the Big South Conference. Jones departed before the 2022-23 season and was replaced by his assistant Phillip Shumpert. Joyner, Jones and Shumpert all took over on an interim basis.

SHUMPERT PAYS HIS DUES

Phillp Shumpert's journey to becoming the North Carolina A&T men's basketball interim head coach took 15 years and many sacrifices. However, the path he took will have him walking into the 2022-23 A&T men's basketball season with 11 players who were on the roster last season, two Division I transfers, two junior college transfers and two true freshmen. Shumpert started as a high school boys basketball coach at Columbia High School in Decatur, Ga. He then moved on to Lawson Community College, where he served as an assistant men's basketball coach and resident assistant in 2007. The following year he became an assistant men's basketball coach at Division II West Alabama. After a year, he returned to Lawson State to serve as the head coach from 2009-2014. He then moved to Southern Poly Tech before the school shut down the men's basketball program in 2015. Shumpert's next opportunity came as an assistant coach at Jackson State before moving back to the high school ranks at Starr's Mills in Fayetteville, Ga. In 2019, he joined the men's basketball staff at A&T under former head coach Jay Joyner. After Joyner's departure, Will Jones became the head coach and kept Shumpert on the staff. Then, over a fateful weekend in mid-August (2022), Shumpert was told Jones would no longer be the head coach at A&T. He was also informed that he would be named the Aggies interim head coach.

A&T'S LETHAL WINGS

Any discussion about the Aggie wingmen starts with 6-foot-6 junior Marcus Watson (Buford, Ga.) and 6-5 Demetric Horton (Raleigh, N.C.). Watson and Horton were the Aggies top two leading scorers and rebounders last season, with Watson averaging 12.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. Meanwhile, Horton averaged 10.7 points and 4.9 rebounds. The two Division I transfers are the top two leading returning scorers and rebounders for the Aggies. Watson had a monster Big South tournament a year ago. He had 18 points and 11 rebounds on 7-for-11 shooting in a first-round overtime win over Radford before scoring 27 points and grabbing 12 rebounds on 10-for-17 shooting in an overtime loss to eventual champion Longwood.

Horton had a hot start to the 2021-22 season, where he connected on 20 3-pointers in the Aggies first eight games. But teams began to focus on the Aggies sharpshooter, making it tougher for him to find open space to get off his shot. The Aggies added shooters during the offseason, something Shumpert hopes will give Horton more open looks. Horton also has good size for a guard, allowing him to muscle his way to the basket and draw fouls.

Watson signed with Oklahoma State out of high school but did not play for the Cowboys. He transferred to New Mexico State, where he scored in double-figures once before coming to A&T. Horton played two years of junior college before transferring Purdue Fort Wayne for one season. He has played in 34 games for the Aggies.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE

The Aggies top two point guards bring with them a national championship background on the junior college level. Kam Woods and Love Bettis both won National Junior College Athletic Association national championships with Woods' coming last season and Bettis' coming the year before. Woods played at Northwest State, where JucoRecruiting.com ranked him as a top-100 JUCO player. He helped the Raiders to a 31-5 record and the NJCAA national championship. Before Northwest Florida, Woods played his freshman year at Troy and averaged 10 points per game.

Bettis helped Coffeyville JC to the national title in 2021. During his first year at Coffeyville, Bettis averaged 11.5 points and shot 45 percent from the floor, 40 percent from three and 93.7 from the line. In addition, he claimed honorable mention All-Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference (KJCCC) accolades en route to a 27-3 record. This past season, he secured first-team All-KJCCC and second-team NJCAA All-American recognition after averaging 18.1 points while shooting 43 percent from the field, 40 percent from three and 86 percent from the line.

The North Carolina A&T men's basketball team is one of four Historically Black Colleges and or Universities (HBCUs) slated to participate in the Boost Mobile HBCU Challenge, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced Tuesday. Twelve-time NBA All-Star and longtime HBCU advocate Chris Paul will host the event at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas, December 17-18.

A&T's national recognition as a premier HBCU continues after participating in the inaugural Invesco QQQ Legacy Classic, a four-team tournament that award-winning actor and film producer Michael B. Jordan partnered with to promote HBCUs this past December. The Aggies have a rich, storied HBCU history, having spent 50 years in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), winning 16 conference tournament championships. Seven of those championships came between 1982-88, tying an NCAA record with Kentucky for consecutive tournament championships.

A&T has 116 all-time meetings between the other three participating HBCUs – Hampton (66), Norfolk State (48) and Texas Southern (2). AggieLand is also home to Naismith Hall of Famers Al Attles and Hugh Evans. Attles became the first-ever player to have his jersey retired as his No. 22 jersey hangs inside the Corbett Sports Center. Evans served as an NBA official for 28 years (1973-2001). He was inducted in September 2022.

HORTON SELECTED FOR HBCU ALL-STAR GAME WATCH

North Carolina A&T senior Demetric Horton has been named to the watch list at shooting guard for the 2023 HBCU All-Star Game to be played Final Four weekend in Houston. Horton has contributed 11.6 points, 3.4 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.5 steals per game and has scored 11 or more points in six of eight contests this winter.

Horton leads the CAA in 3-point field goal percentage as he heads into the week having made 20 of his 40 attempts this season (.500). He is also third in the league in 3-pointers made per game (2.50). Hampton's Marquis Goodwin was also added to the watch list.

The 2023 HBCU All-Star Game will be hosted by Texas Southern on Sunday, April 2 at 4 PM on CBS and Paramount+. The 24 players – 12 per team – will be selected from members of the MEAC, SWAC, CAA, and SIAC, along with Hampton, North Carolina A&T, and Tennessee State. Last season, Aggies legend Kam Langley participated in the game for A&T. He went in as one of the best helpers in NCAA history with 901 career assists to rank 14th all-time.

THE PORTAL

The Aggies dipped into the transfer portal again this season for two Division I talents who are big men. Austin Johnson is a transfer out of UC Irvine, and Will Felton spent one season at Arizona State.

Johnson averaged 5.8 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 80.6 percent from the free throw line at Cal-Irvine last season. He also blocked 2.4 shots per game, which ranked him 23rd nationally. Through his freshman and sophomore years, Johnson played 59 games and averaged 4.7 points and 3.6 rebounds per game. He led the team in field goal percentage as a sophomore at 52.4 percent. He shot 62.5 percent as a freshman.

Felton is the Power Five transfer this season after redshirting his freshman season with Arizona State. He spent his final high school season at Hargrave Military Academy in Chatham, Va. He led the team to a 31-2 record, scoring 15.6 points and grabbing 8.1 rebounds per game while shooting better than 74 percent from the field.

THEY'RE OUT

The Aggies are without two key big men this season. Will Felton, a 6-foot-9, 260-pound redshirt freshman out of Raleigh, NC, tore his ACL during an exhibition game in the preseason and will miss the entire 2022-23 season. Meanwhile, A&T veteran Harry Morris is out with a significant leg injury. Morris is a 6-foot-11 four-year senior out of Dundee, Scotland.

He has been an outstanding shot blocker for the Aggies. He can also step out and hit the three, gives the Aggies a big presence in the paint defensively and he can score in the paint. A&T will have to rely on Division I transfer Austin Johnson, fifth-year senior Webster Filmore and 6-foot-8 redshirt freshman Duncan Powell to provide some punch in the paint.

AGGIES GET A STEAL IN RECRUITING

The Aggies added two true freshman to their 2022 recruiting class over the summer. Point guard Tyrese Elliott and shooting guard Garrison Powell should help make the Aggies transition into the CAA an easier one. Elliott is a three-star recruit and the 11th-best player in Georgia. He averaged 16 points, shot 51 percent from the floor, 45 percent from 3-point range and 81 percent from the free throw line. He also hauled in four rebounds and dished out four assists per night. Elliott's performances translated into

a second-team All-State Class 7A selection and All-Gwinnett County and All-Region honors.

Garrison Powell is out of Atlanta and attended Holy Innocents Episcopal Sin Georgia. He was reported to be considering reclassifying down a year. Powell, who is rated as the nation's No. 41 shooting guard and the Georgia's No. 16 prospect by 247Sports, started to hear from more programs following his junior season. At the next level, Powell had collected offers from Mississippi State, Elon, Siena, Ole Miss, James Madison, Middle Tennessee State and Florida Gulf Coast among others. And he also had interest from Seton Hall and Missouri, Auburn, Maryland, Virginia Tech, Xavier and Stanford.

EVANS JOINS NAISMITH HALL

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame accepted another North Carolina A&T Aggie into its hallowed doors in Hugh Evans. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame recently inducted 13 honorees in the Class of 2022 in September 9-10 during enshrinement festivities in Springfield, Mass. Evans, a longtime NBA referee, entered the Hall along with two-time NBA All-Star and four-time NBA champion Manu Ginobili, five-time NBA All-Star Tim Hardaway, two-time NCAA National Coach of the Year Bob Huggins, and the NBA's sixth-winningest coach of all-time George Karl.

On the women's side, the Hall welcomed five-time WNBA All-Star, three-time WNBA Champion, and two-time Olympic Gold Medalist Lindsay Whalen, four-time WNBA All-Star and two-time Olympic gold medalist Swin Cash and NCAA national champion and WNBA Coach of the Year Marianne Stanley.

Evans, a 2002 inductee into the North Carolina A&T Sports Hall of Fame, played men's basketball for the Aggies from 1959-63 under legendary head coach Cal Irvin. He scored 585 points in 72 games. The Aggies went 63-22 (.741) during Evans' time in AggieLand. After graduating from A&T, Evans served as an NBA Official for 28 consecutive years (1973-2001), tallying over 1,900 regular-season games, 170 playoff games, 35 NBA Finals games and four NBA All-Star Games.

Evans will join fellow Aggie Al Attles in the Naismith Hall. Attles played at A&T from 1956-60. Attles played with the Philadelphia/Golden State Warriors (1960-71) before becoming one of the first African American coaches in NBA history. In 1975, he became the second African American coach in NBA history to win an NBA title.
