QUICKIE NOTES

- The Aggies are closing in on their first MEAC regular-season championship in 28 seasons.
- The Aggies wrapped up their home schedule undefeated against MEAC opponents for the third straight season.
- That gives N.C. A&T a 25-game home winning streak against MEAC opponents going into next season.
- ► If A&T wins tonight, it will be their first outright regular-season title since the 1987-88 season.
- The Aggies have won seven out of the last 10 matchups including a 77-60 win in Greensboro on Feb. 17.
- The Eagles, however, have won the last three MEAC tournaments including a semifinal win over the Aggies in last season's tournament.
- The Aggies have been thriving under acting head coach Will Jones. In the 17 games he has coached, the Aggies are averaging 82.1 points per game.
- ► The Aggies are seventh in the nation in free throw attempts and are 10-0 under Jones when they attempt more free throws than their opponents. Also under Jones, some players have thrived.

- Kameron Langley is shooting 50.8 percent from the floor during Jones' 17-game tenure and he is averaging 9.1 assists.
- Senior Ronald Jackson is averaging 16.4 points and 11.3 rebounds and he is shooting 57.6 percent. Kwe Parker, who will not play tonight, is shooting 52.8 percent since Jones took over.
- The Aggies are 36-11 in the conference over the past three seasons. That is the most wins of any other MEAC school over the past three seasons. The Aggies 55 overall wins are also the most of any MEAC school over the past three years.
- Ronald Jackson is averaging doubledouble at 14.9 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Jackson could become the first Aggie to average a double-double since Bruce Jenkins in 2001-02.
- A&T is led by Langley who leads the nation in total assists (220). His 220 assists is a single-season school record breaking his own single-season record of 208 from last season.
- Langley is the school's all-time leader in assists with 605. He 18 assists shy of the conference record.

RIVALS GO AFTER MEAC REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

- For the first time since NCCU returned to the MEAC in 2011, the longtime rivals, N.C. A&T and N.C. Central will play a winner take-all game for the MEAC regular-season title.
- The Aggies are looking for their 12th MEAC regular-season title and their first since the 1991-92 season when they shared it with Howard.
- ► The Aggies are looking for their first outright title since the 1987-88 season.
- A win would also guarantee the Aggies a winning season for the third straight season. The Aggies have not had three straight winning seasons since they did it four straight seasons from 1990-94.

IF THE AGGIES WIN...

- They will have a 13-3 record in the conference. That would give the Aggies 39 wins in the conference over the past three years. It will be their best stretch since 1985-88 when they won 40 MEAC games.
- It will be their fifth win on the road in the MEAC this season giving the Aggies a winning record on the road in conference play.
- They will improve to 17-14 overall giving the Aggies their third straight winning season.
- They will improve to 7-3 against NCCU in the last 10 matchups.

THE AGGIES OPPONENT

- N.C. Central will try to avenge their loss to N.C. A&T earlier this season when the Aggies held the Eagles to 40.4 percent shooting and outrebounded the Eagles 40-32.
- ➤ The Eagles are led by Jibri Blount who leads the conference in scoring at 19.3 points per game. He is also third in the conference rebounding at 9.3 per game.
- ▶ Blount shoots 53.3 percent from the floor and 34.3 percent from 3-point range.
- The Eagles have won four straight since losing to the Aggies on Feb. 17. They are undefeated at home at 11-0.
- ► The Eagles are led by head coach LeVelle Moton who has led NCCU to the last three MEAC titles and he has four championships overall in the conference.

ONE YEAR WONDERS

- The Aggies have specialized in players staying for one year and making an immediate impact.
- The one-year talent started during the 2015-16 season when the Aggies brought in Ede Egharevba out of Albany Unviversity.
- Egharevba averaged 7.1 points and helped then interim coach Jay Joyner finish the regular season 5-4 before Joyner took over on a full-time basis.
- ▶ In Joyner's second full season, he brought in Oakland transfer Femi Olujobi. Olujobi led the nation in scoring over the first few weeks of the season and eventually helped the Aggies win 20 games and earn a postseason bid to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.
- Olujobi led the Aggies in scoring at 16.3 points per game.
- Last season, the Aggies had several one-year players come in and make an impact as the Aggies went 19-13 overall and 13-3 in the MEAC.
- Guard Qua Copeland led the Aggies in scoring while making 41 3-pointers after transferring out of Middle Tennessee.
- ► Forward Terry Harris led the Aggies in 3-pointers made with 60 and was one of the nation's best 3-point shooters. He transferred to N.C. A&T out of Eastern Michigan.
- ▶ Ibrahim Sylla transferred out of Colorado State and stayed one season to lead the Aggies in rebounding at 5.3 per game. He also led the Aggies in field goal percentage (.599).
- This season, the Aggies will look to Devin Haygood to be their one-year wonder after he transferred out of Youngstown State. He had two points in his Aggies debut.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- The Aggies have been successful over the past two seasons despite not having a preseason or postseason first-team All-MEAC player.
- This season the Aggies did not have anyone placed on the MEAC's preseason first team as point guard Kameron Langley was second team.

- N.C. A&T also brought in sharpshooting guard Tyler Maye out of VCU. Maye averaged 7.4 minutes in 32 games played as a freshman at VCU.
- ► He then transferred to SCC in lowa and averaged 11.4 points while knocking down 45 percent of his 3-point shots.

AGGIES BRING IN FRESH CLASS

- ► The Aggies freshman class is highlighted by the signing of Chicago native Fred Cleveland, Jr. Cleveland is considered the replacement for Kameron Langley who is a junior this season. Cleveland is an outstanding shooter and he also distributes the basketball well.
- The Aggies alslo went overseas to bring in some talent as Harry Morrice joins the Aggies out of the United Kingdom. Morrice averaged 16.0 points and 8.0 rebounds last season in high school.

- ► He gives the Aggies another big body after averaging a double-double at Liberty Heights Athletic Institute last season. N.C. A&T also brought on walkin Jibril McCormick out of Charlotte, N.C.

► PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- N.C. A&T has spent some time in first place this season and that has yielded them some weekly honors.
- ► Kameron Langley earned the program's first Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) offensive player of the week honor in two years when he earned the honor on Jan. 28 follwing the school's first triple-double in modern history as he posted 15 points, 12 assists and 10 rebounds in a win over Delaware State on Jan. 27.
- N.C. A&T has earned two MEAC defensive player of the week honors this season both by senior forward Ronald Jackson. He earned his first honor on Jan. 14 after a week where he posted 18 defensive rebounds and three blocks.
- ► His second honor came on Feb. 4 after wins over the then top team in the conference Norfolk State and S.C. State.
- The Aggie freshman have also gotten into the act.
- Freshman Fred Cleveland Jr., has two MEAC rookie of the year honors this season while fellow freshman teammate Harry Morrice has one.
- ➤ Cleveland earned his first weekly honor during the non-conference season as he had a combined 35 points in two games at the UTEP tournament including going 6-for-9 from 3-point range.
- ► He got his second honor after scoring 10 points at Coppin State.

 Morrice's honor came after he scored 12 points and had eight rebounds against Mid-Atlantic Christian.

THE LANGLEY BROTHERS

- ► Kameron Langley is one of the best point guards in the MEAC. Langley led the MEAC in assists last season was 13th in the nation at 6.7 per game. In two years, Langley has compiled 287 assists in his career.
- ▶ But Langley is not the only college basketball player in his family. Three other Langley brothers have or are currently occuping the court in college hoops in Greensboro. He has squared off against all his brothers at some point in his career.
- ► Last season, Langley played against his older brother Keyford Langley of Division III Greensboro College. Keyford, who is also a point guard, finished with 14 points, five rebounds and eight assists with only one turnover in the Aggies 92-67 win.
- ► For his part, Kameron, had eight points, seven assists and two steals.
- ► Two other Langley brothers have come into the fold this season as twins Keyshaun and Kobe Langley suit up for the UNC Greensboro Spartans next season.
- ► The Aggies and the Spartans played at the Greensboro Coliseum on Nov. 5 where Kameron started for the Aggies and Keyshaun came off the bench. Kobe did not play.
- ➤ Kameron finished with seven points and two assists while Keyshaun finished with seven points and six assists.
- ► The two teams will play again next season at Corbett Sports Center. Kameron is 1-1 when playing against his brothers in an NCAA Division I college basketball game.
- ► There is no word on what their record is against each other when playing in the backyard in Greensboro.

WHERE ARE THE FOUR-YEAR SENIORS?

- They are not on the North Carolina A&T menn's basketball roster.
- The Aggies do not have a four-year senior on the roster this season. It is not because they are a young team. In fact, the Aggies have three seniors on the team in Ronald Jackson, Andre Jackson and Devin Haygood.
- ▶ But the two Jacksons are junior college transfers and Haygood is a graduate transfer.
- The Aggies turnover the last three years has caused the Aggies not to have a four-year class.
- Last season, the Aggies only had one four-year senior in Amari Hamilton. In the future, however, the Aggies have plenty of potential to honor four-year seniors.
- Junior Kameron Langley has been at A&T since his freshman season. He will be the only four-year senior on the roster next season.
- Sophomores Tyrone Lyons and Webster Filmore have also been in the program since their freshman seasons.

NO FIRST-TEAM HONORS

- ➤ The Aggies have not had a first-team All-MEAC performer since the 2010-11 season when center Thomas Coleman earned the honor.
- This is the longest streak the Aggies have gone without having a first-team performer.
- The Aggies have won a MEAC title since the 2010-11 season despite not having a first-team player.

HEAD COACH JAY JOYNER

Jay Joyner was announced as the head men's basketball coach at North Carolina A&T hours before the Aggies faced Coppin State in a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Basketball Championship Tournament game on March 7, 2016. Joyner was named interim head coach weeks earlier on Jan. 29, 2016 after the resignation of Cy Alexander.

Under Joyner, the Aggies closed out the 2015-16 regular season with a 5-4 record overall and a 5-3 mark in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. After a tough season in his first full season as the Aggies head coach, Joyner first spearheaded one of the best turnarounds in Division I history before following up with a 19-win season that included a second-place finish in the MEAC during the 2018-19 season.

The Aggies 13-3 record in the MEAC in 2018-19 marked the first time the program has finished second since the 1992-93 season and it was the most conference wins the Aggies have accumulated since the 1987-88 season. Joyner also led the Aggies to 39 wins from 2017-2019. Those are the most wins over a two-year period since the Aggies won 50 games from 1986-88.

Joyner accomplished another feat that had not been achieved in a long time when he was named coach of the year in the MEAC following the 2017-18 season. He became the first N.C. A&T men's basketball coach to earn the award since Don Corbett received it after the 1987-88 season. He was also named the National Association Basketball Coaches District 15 coach of the year.

He was rewarded because the Aggies improved 17 games from the 2016-17 season to the 2017-18 season coming one game shy of tying UTEP's 18-game improvement in 2003-04. The Aggies finished 20-15 (.571) in 2017-18 marking the Aggies first 20-win season in five years and just the third in the past 30 years. The Aggies also put together their best winning percentage since the 1991-92 season. Their 18 regular-season wins were the most since '91-92.

Joyner led the Aggies to their first MEAC tournament win in five seasons when the Aggies won twice in the 2017-18 conference tournament. Their No. 4 seed in the tournament was the school's highest seeding since 2009. Joyner also led the Aggies to their first undefeated season at home

in 30 seasons as the Aggies went 12-0 at Corbett Sports Center. In fact, the Aggies have won 17 straight games at home against conference foes under Joyner's leadership.

The 2017-18 season saw the Aggies break the school single-season record for points (2,623). The following season, point guard Kameron Langley broke the school's single-season assists record (208).

Before becoming N.C. A&T's head coach, Joyner furthered his longtime relationship with Alexander as he served as the Aggies associate head coach (2012-16) under Alexander. Previously Joyner had played for Alexander as a student-athlete at S.C. State. He also worked with Alexander as an assistant prior to N.C. A&T. Alexander even served on Joyner's staff at Columbia State Community College.

As the Aggies associate head coach, Joyner took the lead in the Aggies recruiting efforts. In his first season with the Aggies program, the Aggies won the MEAC title, won its first-ever NCAA tournament game and won 20 games for the first time in 25 years. Before coming to Greensboro, Joyner spent three seasons as the head men's basketball coach at Columbia State Community College, a two-year school in Middle Tennessee. Joyner led the Chargers to a 61-23 record and two Tennessee Community College Athletic Association regular-season titles.

In 2012, the Charges made their first national tournament appearance in 34 years. The 2011-12 team went 23-8 and finished the season ranked sixth in the nation. Joyner earned the 2011-12 National Junior College Athletic Association District 7 Coach of the Year honor and was named the TCCAA Coach of the Year in 2010 and '12.

Joyner spent the 2008-2009 season as an assistant coach for the Cumberland University men's basketball program, a National Association Intercollegiate Athletics institution, in Lebanon, Tenn. He helped the Bulldogs to an NAIA National Championship Tournament appearance with a 26-6 record.

Prior to finding success in Tennessee, Joyner gained experience working in the Big East. Joyner served as the director of player development for Rutgers University (2006-08), and spent two seasons developing and managing the Scarlett Knights' mentoring program. He worked with each student-athlete to help enhance their athletic performance, handled NCAA compliance documentation for student-athletes, served as the campus liaison for recruits and assisted with scheduling.

His coaching career began in Tennessee, where he served as the assistant coach at Columbia State Community College for the 2005-06 season, helping guide the Chargers to the conference championship game under head coach Malcolm Montgomery.

Joyner got his professional start in athletics in 2003, where he served as the administrative assistant/assistant strength coach for the men's basketball program at Tennessee State under Alexander. Before making the jump to collegiate athletics, Joyner was an assistant boys basketball coach at Centennial High School in Franklin, Tenn., for the 2002-03 season.
